TERMS OF REFERENCE

The ACD sponsors two awards for graduate students. These prestigious Graduate Student Awards are named in honour of two senior and well-known Canadian analytical chemists: Douglas Ryan of the Faculty of the Trace Analysis Research Centre (TARC) at Dalhousie University, and Walter E. Harris of the Department of Chemistry, University of Alberta. The Douglas E. Ryan Award and The Walter E. Harris Award are presented in alternate years.

Nomination shall be open to every graduate student enrolled in a Canadian University whose Ph.D. thesis research is in a field of Analytical Chemistry. The selection of the recipient is made on the basis of research contribution and the excellence of academic record.

The recipient of the award receives a cash award (\$750) and framed certificate, and is expected to make a presentation at the next annual CSC meeting. The award recipient will also be reimbursed for the cost of conference registration and travel expenses up to \$500.

The finances to maintain these two Graduate Student Awards were raised by friends and colleagues of Dr. Harris and Dr. Ryan as well as from a donation by Dr. Harris.
