<u>Goal 1:</u> The Lake Bloomington Association (LBA) will contribute to the ongoing development of a vibrant community spirit by hosting social events and conducting communication activities.

Initiatives:

- \circ Hold monthly board meetings.
- Continue to maintain an active website and Facebook page.
- Produce quarterly newsletters to be distributed to all association members.
- Update the LBA By-laws.
- Host social events throughout the year including:
 - A Fourth of July celebration, with fireworks and a pontoon parade.
 - An annual Winter social
 - An annual Spring dinner
 - A Fall dinner and annual LBA meeting

<u>Goal 2:</u> The LBA will engage existing membership and encourage new members to join.

Initiatives:

- Maintain an accurate membership database.
- Develop a new program to solicit for annual membership dues.
- Establish a new Area Captain Program. Area Captains will contact all new residents with membership, safety, and other lake living information.
- Conduct a survey of residents' needs and be a forum for other member communication.

Goal 3: The LBA will educate members and the public to promote safety and to help maintain a safe recreational and water resource for all.

Goal 4: The LBA will participate in the protection and improvement of the quality of the Lake's ecosystem.

Initiatives:

- Host a spring clean-up around the lake and participate in the planned North Park work day.
- Collaborate with Friends of Everbloom and contribute to their ongoing initiatives.
- Develop a Chlorine Tablet program to promote timely chlorination of resident septic systems.

Goal 5: The Lake Bloomington Association will improve the physical surroundings of the Lake and support the investment made by homeowners of the Lake community.

Initiatives:

- Install new and consistent address signage around the lake.
- Collaborate with the city on improvements to the surrounding areas of the lake, including the development of a dog park at North Park and renovation of Association Park.

Goal 6: The LBA will foster a strong, collaborative relationship with Lake Bloomington stakeholders including the City of Bloomington, the McLean County Board, Friends of Everbloom and the Lake Camps.

- Continue to be supportive of the needs of Timber Pointe Outdoor Center and East Bay Camp, and support the Timber Pointe Yacht Club.
