

Colorado Futurity Arrival and Social Distancing Protocols

Upon Arrival

- State Fair Staff will be stationed at point of entry to the venue and will conduct a health screening on all wishing to enter the grounds. Entry will be denied if anyone has a temperature of 100.4 or higher, has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days, and/or is not wearing a face covering.
- All Exhibitors will enter and exit from gate 6 off Small Avenue
- Exhibitors will be asked to provide signed waiver/pledge document.
- Exhibitors will be given a wrist band for entrance
- All contestant groups will be spread out stall wise with a minimum of one open stall between groups.
- Hand wash stations and sanitizer shall be available throughout the venue.
- Shavings will be delivered to stalls prior to contestant arrival.
- RV Camping will be placed at every other space when staying overnight. Reserved spots will be marked prior to arrivals
- Physical Distancing strategies to maintain a minimum of 6 feet physical distancing must be used throughout the event.
- In the warmup arena there will be no more than 20 competitors on horseback at a time warming up.
- Schedule and draws will be posted online we ask participants to remain at their barn until 30 minutes before their run at which time they can come to the warmup arena and then run. After the run they will be asked to move to the smaller arena for cool down
- When spectating please keep a six-foot social distancing in mind.
- There will be no vendors.
- There will be no outside spectators. Only those entered or traveling with family will be allowed Camping and parking spots will be marked for Exhibitors parking
- Photographer and Video Booths will serve customers with proper social distancing, this may require one customer at a time.
- The Horse Show Complex is roughly 10 acres in size with over 400 horse stalls spread across the complex. This complex will be split into **3 separate extra-large** outdoor venues (Stall area 1, stall area 2, and show rings)
- **Extra-large** outdoor venues will have a maximum number of 175 people at the venue. We ask that after competing when possible you return to your stalls or warm up/cool down pen.
- The show will be livestreamed to reduce on site spectators.
- Participants will be **required** to wear a face covering **when not showing; (on horseback) or at their own stalls/camper physically distanced from others aside from their household/barn unit.**
- A fiberglass barrier will be placed in front of the announcer.
