Our steer market wasn't really tested, but we did have a few good cattle that sold very well. We've had a little break here after the Draft and Haflinger sale and we are ready to get cranked back up in the Horse Arena. We have the Riding Horse Auction and the Dutch Cross Classic the next couple of weeks. Both events have some entertainment scheduled in. Bring the family and come check out TLA!
