RULES

Pick and circle one Pro Golfer from each group above. Each Pro Golfer will earn points for every individual tournament as shown below. Points are awarded based on the official score (strokes) for each golfer according to the PGA Tour website. In case of a tie, each golfer will receive the amount of points assigned for that position. Winners are responsible for contacting the administrator.

Golfer points: 1st=40pts, 2nd=30pts, 3rd=25pts, 4th=20pts, 5th=15pts, 6th=10pts, 7th=8pts, 8th=6pts, 9th=4pts, 10th=2pts.



Double points will be awarded for 5 weekends:

The Masters - April 7 thru April 10
 The US Open - June 16 thru June 19
 The Open - July 14 thru July 17
 The PGA Championship - Jul. 28- Jul. 31
 The Tour Championship - Sep. 22 thru Sep. 25

We'll count 34 tournaments from The CareerBuilder Challenge (Jan 21-24, 2016) to The Tour Championship (Sep 22-25, 2016). Only individual tournaments count. No points awarded for match play or team events. Actual payout will be determined by the number of entries. We are NOT counting: P.R. Open 3/24-3/27, WGC Match Play 3/23-3/37, Barracuda 6/30-7/3, Barbasol 7/14-7/17, Olympic 8/11-8/14.

Payouts will be determined by the total number of entries. We use an averaged payout system, and in case of a tie, the prize pool will be averaged among the winners for each position.

RULES

You must be entered in the Main Pool to participate in the optional Bonus Pool. Your picks and points earned will be the same as in the Main Pool, and the Bonus Pools will be limited to groups of approximately 100 entries. Additional Bonus Pools will be created as needed, with a similar amount in each, and there could be more or less than 100 in each pool. Entries will be placed in the Bonus Pools on a first come first served basis, and if you have more than one entry, you will be placed in different Bonus Pools (if available) unless you request otherwise.

Payouts will be determined by the total number of entries. Payouts will be averaged (like the main pool) in case of a tie.
