1. Attached, please find the note I just wrote to my own kiddos who have not yet registered online for NSDA. You may modify it as you like for your own kids. They need to register online as NSDA members. This will give them full access to the NSDA website, allow NSDA to contact them regarding college scholarships (this is optional for the kids), and will also let them COUNT for YOUR TEAM for your team strength.

Explanation: only registered team members can compete at the District Tournament. Also, only registered team members count in the STRENGTH part of your chapter (find your chapter here: http://points.speechanddebate.org/points_application/reports.php) Thus, you want to maximize the number of students who are registered so you can maximize the size of your entry to Districts!
