PRESENTATION DESCRIPTION

In Accelerated Bridge Construction (ABC) methods, one way to connect prefabricated columns is by using grouted steel bar couplers. At the present time, in the U.S., only the State of Utah allows the use of grouted couplers in plastic hinge locations in seismic zones. A study funded by the Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) was carried out on seismic performance of grouted coupler column-to-footing and column-to-bent cap connections under Idaho seismic conditions. The performance of grouted coupler connections is compared to the conventional cast-in-place connections. Three Idaho bridges were selected by ITD for computer analysis using OpenSees finite element analysis program. Experimental data provided the necessary input to model the grouted couplers used in the bridge columns. The bridges were placed in the most seismically active location in Idaho. All three bridge columns performed well. The stresses in both the longitudinal reinforcing bars and the grouted coupler regions are well within acceptable ranges. The largest column drift, using combination of orthogonal displacements, is 1.6 percent. The single column analysis under large drift shows that grouted couplers may be used to connect precast columns to footings or cap beams when column drift is less than 4 percent.

PRESENTATION: Reinforced Concrete Sewer Pipe Collapse, Dr. Nathan Harris, BYU-Idaho

PRESENTATION DESCRIPTION

A 30-year old, 54-inch reinforced concrete trunk sewer at a treatment plant in Carlsbad, California collapsed with little warning, completely blocking flow. The pipe carried approximately 17 mgd of sewage to the treatment plant headworks with no redundancy. The failure resulted in sewage exiting manholes just upstream of the collapse. After the flow was rerouted through temporary above ground pipes, a 300-ft long section of the pipe was excavated and replaced. Exponent, Inc. (formerly Failure Analysis Associates) conducted an investigation into the cause of the collapse. A description of events surrounding the failure (including photographs taken as the failure occurred), the factors contributing to failure of the pipe, and lessons learned will be discussed.

Fluid flow can be a very complex and often misunderstood. In the past, hydraulic structures have primarily been designed using simplified equations, design nomographs and physical models. In the last two decades, computing power and numerical algorithms have significantly improved allowing numerical modeling to be used in research and the design process. Specifically, Computational Fluid Dynamics (CFD) or the numerical solution to the Reynolds-Averaged Navier-Stokes equations, has become a viable tool in the design of hydraulic structures such as dams, spillways and fish ladders. The use of CFD compliments physical modeling and has created a new area titled composite modeling. In this presentation, the concept of CFD is briefly introduced along with physical modeling. Several design and research projects that have used CFD, including an RCC stepped-spillway project in Grace, Idaho, will be presented.

SUBJECT: Traffic Signal Removal in Idaho Falls, Kent Fugal, City of Idaho Falls

Due to problems achieving two-way progression due to inappropriate signal spacing and suspicion that a number of traffic signals didn't meet signal warrants, the City of Idaho Falls and ITD hired a consultant to evaluate 12 intersections for potential removal. A preliminary screening process evaluated signal warrants, sight distance issues, and crash history to narrow the list from 12 locations to six. A more detailed analysis at the six remaining study intersections, including field delay studies before and during temporary removal of the signals, in-depth traffic analysis, cost evaluation, and public outreach, was performed and all six remaining intersections were recommended for removal to the elected officials. Five of the six were removed in 2016 and it was determined that the sixth should not be removed until after improvements are made at another signal nearby. This presentation will cover some history of signal removal in Idaho Falls, the process that was followed for the recent study, study results, actions taken, and what may be ahead.

Kent Fugal has been the Idaho Falls City Engineer since September 2011, having previously worked for various consulting firms and the cities of Pleasant Grove, Utah and Glendale, Arizona. Most of his work experience is in the fields of traffic engineering and roadway design, but he has also completed many designs and studies in the general municipal and utility disciplines. He has B.S. and M.S. degrees in Civil Engineering from Brigham Young University and did additional graduate work at Arizona State University.

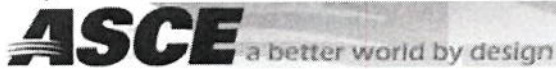
