SAFE (Safety Awareness for Everyone) and the SFPD want to prevent your bike from being a victim. Find important resources and register your bicycle for free at safebikes.org. Registering your bicycle acts as a theft deterrent and helps aid in recovery if your bike is stolen.

YOUR BIKE IS STOLEN—NOW WHAT?

- File a Police Report**—In person at a district station or at sf-police.org.
- Provide pictures and a serial number** of your bicycle to police.
- No bike photos or serial number? **Contact seller and obtain receipt if possible.**
- Post bicycle to Craigslist, set up a Google alert, or use IFTTT.com** to monitor the web for your bicycle. If found, contact the SFPD.
- Do not attempt to get your bicycle back by yourself**—notify the SFPD.
