## Meeting Minutes March 1, 2023 7:00 P.M.

The Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 4 (ESD 4) conducted a meeting at 28036 Old Boerne Stage Road, Boerne, Texas, 78006 on Wednesday March 1, 2023, at 7:00 P.M. The following was discussed:

- 1. Commissioner Huber called the Bexar County ESD 4 Meeting to Order at 7:00 P.M. and established a quorum. Commissioner Rasmussen was unable to attend.
- 2. Citizen Public Forum. No citizens chose to speak.
- 3. The Board discussed the District priorities and 5-year strategic planning.
  - a. Mr. Josh Brown, Administrator ESD 2, discussed lessons learned from ESD 2 with full-time personnel and medical transport. Highlights were:
    - Fire fighter compensation, ensure personnel are being properly compensated for overtime and compensation level to retain personnel.
    - Fire fighter certifications with the State.
    - Ambulance usage, plan on replacing ambulances frequently.
    - Budget for expenses on the high side and be conservative with income and run multiple planning scenarios for contingencies.
  - b. Mr. Charles Laljer, ESD 4 Administrator, presented priority recommendations coordinated with Leon Springs Fire Department (LSFD). Priorities were:
    - Continue moving toward full-time staffing.
    - Replace aging fire trucks, order a second truck now for delivery in 2025.
    - Initiate medical transport in Fiscal Year (FY) 2025.
    - Procure property along IH-10 for a future fire station.
    - Build up the ESD 4 reserve fund.
  - c. Mr. Laljer presented an in-depth discussion on each priority and recommendation. The Commissioners concurred with the priorities. Commissioner Haygood stressed the need to accelerate looking for property along IH-10 given the growth rate and scarcity. Commissioner Surratt focused on the long-term financial projections and impact on the District tax rate. Action on recommendations to request LSFD add personnel in FY23 and procure a second truck were deferred until the March 6, 2023 Board Meeting.
- 4. Determine date, time, and possible agenda items for the next meeting. The next regularly scheduled Board meeting will be Monday, March 6, 2023.
- 5. Adjourn. With no further business before the Board, Commissioner Surratt made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Haygood seconded the motion. Motion carried by a 4/0 vote in favor of. Meeting was adjourned at 9:16 P.M.
