### DOES A WOMAN FORGET HER BABY?

There's a touching story told about a poor woman whose son caused her endless trouble. He wouldn't work. He spent the time drinking and mixing around with bad company. He even stole from her in order to indulge his pleasures. No matter how much she pleaded with him to change his life, he refused to do so. He broke her heart and made her very unhappy. Eventually, and to no one's big surprise, he ended up in prison. Most of her friends thought that finally she would get some respite. Not at all. She visited him faithfully every week and brought him whatever she could afford to buy. One day, a friend remarked, "That son of yours has ruined your life. He'll not change. Why don't you just forget about him and move on with your life?" "How can I?" she replied, "I don't like what he's done, but he's still my son, the child of my womb."

Often when things in our life go wrong or when our plans go awry, we are tempted to think that God has abandoned us. We feel as though God has forgotten us. This is natural and understandable. The people in the time of the Prophet Isaiah felt the same way when everything they hoped for was lost. Their temple was destroyed. Their homes were lost. Their freedom was taken away from them. They were exiled in a foreign land. And, by the rivers of Babylon they could only sit and weep as they remembered Jerusalem. They lost all hope and joy. They could not even sing the songs of the Lord in that strange land. It was then that God sent Isaiah to assure them that they were not abandoned nor forgotten. God remembered them. Isaiah used the tender image of a mother's steadfast and sacrificing love for her child to tell the people that God will always remember and cherish them.

A loving mother never gives up on her child no matter what. And, if a human mother is capable of such unmeasured love, then how much greater is God's love for us who are His own children? This tender "motherly" love of God for us is not something soft and sentimental. It is the firm and solid assurance that we can rest secure because God alone is our "rock", our "stronghold" and our "fortress". This faith in God frees us from needless worry and anxiety. Worry is essentially our lack of faith and trust in God. Yet, God has faith in us that in Jesus Christ, we have been made stewards "entrusted with the mysteries of God." So, as good stewards and as children of God let us put our past, our present, and our future in the hands of God – the God who never abandons nor forgets us.


