

Bits 'N' Pieces 4-H club meeting minutes, February 8th 2015

The meeting was called to order at 1:45PM, then we did the US and 4-H pledges.

The secretary's report was read by secretary Sandis W, there were no additions or corrections. It was moved by Rachel W and 2nd by Emmett WB that the report stand as read.

Old Business

Covenant farms – At the farm we learned how to milk a cow, saw the herd, learned about rotational grazing, humane treatment, and treating infections.

Carnival, March 21st from 10am-7pm –

Sweets: Last year each member had to bring 1-9" cake single layer, 12 cupcakes individually wrapped, and 12 brownies or cookies wrapped in packs of 2, and 1-12 pack of soda per family. This year it was moved by Rachel W and 2nd by Emmett WB, that every member must bring 2-9" cakes single layer and 36 total of the following items: cookies, brownies, cupcakes, and/or doughnuts. All items must be individually wrapped. Do not bring cakes or other items in a container you want to keep, because we have to give them out in the container. You can buy disposable containers at a dollar store. Also, each family must bring a 12 pack of soda, but NO GINGER ALE. If you can't be there or can't make your sweets, instead you can give Jennifer W a minimum of \$20 by the March club meeting so they can buy the sweets for you. Sign up for what you will be bringing on the website.

Carnival Shifts: Each shift will be 2 hours except the last one which will be 3 hours. Members and parents, except supervisors must sign up for 2 shifts, and cloverbuds 1 shift. In addition, everyone must do either setup on Friday night or take down Saturday. Number of people needed per shift by game is: Wheel of Sweets, 1 kid and no adults, Flying Hawaiian Chicken, 2 kids and 1 adult, Bean bag toss, 1 kid and 1 adult, (Flying Hawaiian Chicken and Bean bag toss will share 1 kid to hand out prizes), Face Painting, 4 kids and 1 adult. There will be sign up for shifts on the website. There will also be 1 hr shifts for 2 adults at 1pm and at 6pm to count tickets. It was moved by Rachel W and 2nd by Cora WB to accept all of the above shift times.

Prizes: Prizes will need to be brought to set up, or you can give to someone to bring to set up. Prizes can be small toys, books or coin purses, basically anything kids will like.

T-shirts – The last T-shirt order will be placed soon. If you are new or need a larger size shirt, you should check after the meeting to see if you can get a used shirt.

Bear Delivery – We will have three bear deliveries. The first will be Saturday the 14th at nursing home where we will meet in the lobby then go upstairs to deliver the bears. Second, Hearts and Horses delivery will be Monday the 16th at 4:30 and include a tour if the weather is good. Lastly, the Windsor nursing home delivery will be Friday the 20th at 4:30.
