No Local Law shall be adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Cohocton, New York until a public hearing has been held thereon in its final form before such Board of Trustees not less than five (5) nor more than twenty (20) days after public notice has been given of the time and place of the holding of such public hearing. Such notice shall be given by the Village Clerk by causing the same to be published, once, in the official newspaper of the Village of Cohocton, New York. Such notice shall contain the title of the proposed Local Law and a brief explanatory statement thereof.

SECTION II

The Village Clerk shall cause to be printed or otherwise reproduced copies of such proposed Local Law and shall, not later than the date such notice is published, post one such copy together with the notice of hearing in a conspicuous place in his office and such other places as may cause to give sufficient notice of said public law throughout the Village of Cohocton, New York and shall also make copies of such proposed local law available at the office of the Village Clerk for inspection by any interested person during business hours.

SECTION III

Upon the final adoption of any local law by the Board of Trustees, the Village Clerk shall file a copy of the same in the office of the Village Clerk in a registry or index kept and maintained by the Village Clerk for such purposes and shall further cause copies of the same to be filed with the office of the New York State Secretary of State and the office of the New York State Comptroller, as may be required by law.

SECTION IV

The Village Clerk shall cause to be published, in abstract form, in the official newspaper of the Village of Cohocton, New York any local law finally adopted by the Board of Trustees which shall be required to be published as shall be mandated by any law, rule regulation.
