For over twelve years the school and parish communities have been dreaming, planning, fundraising, and designing the extension to the existing school building.

The dream is finally becoming a reality. It would be most appropriate to thank wholeheartedly all who have made it possible. There are many individuals and groups that we owe our gratitude. Let me thank every single one of them for their contribution of time, treasure, talent to the project.

I will not be able to mention each one by name but would like to acknowledge publicly the Alsam Foundation without whose generous donation the project would not be possible at all.

As you noticed there is already some prep work being done with more to come in the next days and months. (most likely until August) The construction area has been fenced off for children's and everyone's safety. If you lost your favorite parking spot, please consider finding another one on the East side of Father McNamara Center or down closer to Orchard Drive.

I ask for your understanding, patience and prayer for a successful completion of the project. The present cost has raised to \$3.6 million which will leave us \$700,000 short of what we have at present. If you are able to contribute to the shortfall, please contact us (Principal McFall, Fr. Andrzej, Deacon Dodge or the office) to commemorate your name for generations to come.

The multipurpose room which is a part of the extension will serve the parish activities as well.
