

MINUTES OF MEETING OF NOV. 27,1992

MEETING CONVENED AT 8:30 PM. COMMANDER GENE REMIREZ PRESIDING. ALL ELECTED OFFICERS PRESENT. 36 MEMBERS PRESENT.

PRIOR TO THE START OF THE MEETING, ADJUTANT FERDIE SALVATORE INFORMED THE MEMBERS THAT THE POST WON A MEMBERSHIP INCENTIVE AWARD AT THE LAST COUNTY MEETING. THE POST MEMBERSHIP INCREASED LAST YEAR FROM 178 TO 204 AN INCREASE OF 26 RESULTING IN AN AWARD OF \$ 52. THE INCENTIVE AWARDS WERE GIVEN OUT TO ONLY THREE POSTS ON STATEN ISLAND.

HOSPITAL VISITATION- VINCENT ZANGARI SAID HE PAID A VISIT TO JEFF JEANETTE. JEFF HAS VISION PROBLEMS AND IS UNDER TREATMENT AND HE CAN NO LONGER DRIVE.

POST ACTIVITIES-CHARLES FONTANA SAID THE DEC.12 CHRISTMAS PARTY DINNER DANCE WAS SOLD OUT AND ONLY POST MEMBERS AND THEIR GUEST ARE ATTENDING.
