2018 marks MEF's 35th year as an education foundation. We are the longest operating public education foundation in Northwestern Pennsylvania and have provided

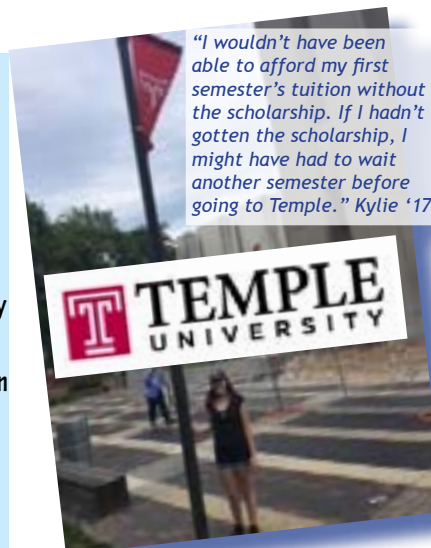
