## **Lynchburg Leadership Program Commitments**

Class members must reside in or be employed in Moore County. Participants will be selected each year who are most apt to utilize their leadership ability for the long-term benefit of the community. Class size will be limited to no more than 10 people per class.

Tuition for the class is \$150. Course fees may be waived for good cause or hardship as determined by the Board.

## Persons will be favored for selection who:

- 1. Have demonstrated a desire to serve the community by past civic activities.
- 2. Are willing to seek leadership roles on public and private boards, in volunteer organizations, or in public office.
- 3. Are motivated to improve their skills.
- 4. Have potential for advancement to leadership positions.
- 5. Have an occupation such that they are not likely to be relocating from the county in the immediate future.
- 6. Will commit to participate fully in the Lynchburg Leadership program, meet its attendance requirements, and as alumni continue their involvement with the program as resource persons, program planners, committee members, mentors, or other roles as needed.

Lynchburg Leadership is designed as a total experience in which a class member attends an orientation retreat and monthly sessions. Different topics are addressed at each session. Class members should attend all sessions to receive the benefit of the program.

## In order to graduate, a class participant must:

- (a) Attend an orientation retreat. If he/she cannot attend the retreat, tuition fees will be refunded and the individual may reapply for the next year's class.
- (b) Attend five of the six monthly leadership class days; provided, however, the Board of Directors may approve for good cause one additional absence for a candidate. Participants who miss more than two monthly meetings will not be eligible to graduate.
- (c) Attend one of the following public government meetings during the duration of the program:

  Metropolitan Lynchburg/ Moore County Council Meeting; Moore County Schools Board Meeting
- (d) Participate in completing one Community Project.
- (e) Complete a number of community activities specified and approved by the Board of Directors.
