Registration changes from \$3,000.00 to \$3,500.00 total income remain the same \$6,500.00. Under Total Membership Income, Quartermaster Income change from \$13,000.00 to \$13,750.00. Below registration, in parenthesis put SEC October/February, total has changed from \$3,200.00 to \$3,900.00. Talking Cup, delete that completely. Total Income \$143,460.00. Under Convention Expense, Convention Book, change from \$1,500.00 to \$2,500.00. Department Awards, change from \$100.00 to \$200.00, now the Convention Expense Total is \$14,780.00. Next Page 32, under Headquarters, Printed SEC October/February book, change \$1,500.00 to \$1,800.00. Add a line item, "Printing /Other"- total \$250.00, total Headquarters Expense will be \$5,950.00.
