



Procedures & Preparations for Roaches, Ants, Silverfish

Thorough adherence to these instructions is **mandatory** to properly treat and eliminate the bedbug infestation.

Prior To Treatment:

Before our Roach Treatment, Customer must complete the following:

- Remove all materials, including dishes, pots, pans, utensils, and food from the kitchen cabinets, drawers, and counters. Place these items on the dining room table, in the center of the living room or on the couch and cover
- Remove all materials from the bathroom cabinets, including the medicine cabinet and drawers. Put these items on the bed and the center of the living room or on the couch and cover.
- If any items are left on the kitchen floor or adjacent areas, keep them at least three (3) feet from the wall bare areas.
- ANY scrubbing or cleaning of cupboards, walls or shelves should be done **BEFORE** treating occurs.
- Remove all pets for at least a four (4) hour period. Pet birds must be removed.
- Aquariums should be sealed off with plastic wrapping, and the filter must be turned off for 4 hours.
- Owner or Tenant needs to **move Refrigerator and Stove 1 ft. away from the Wall.**

Post Treatment:

- Ventilate all treated areas by opening doors and windows, etc., in all rooms or at least 30 minutes. To exchange inside air with outside air. Fans will help speed the ventilation time.
 - Indications of ventilated area are no visible haze of insecticide and little or no insecticide order.
- Clean the counter tops with soap and water.
 - Only use water if you clean the inside of the cabinets, no soap.
