## Coordinators Corner

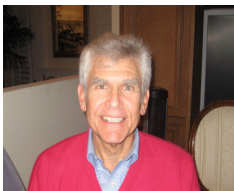
We hope that everyone has had a healthy and happy holiday season.

**MY MEMORABLE VISIT TO THE LA RONALD MCDONALD HOUSE by Elise Sandler**

Neil and I had an amazing day at the Ronald McDonald House! The place consists of two buildings planned to help families be near or with their children who are receiving treatment for critical ailments and even transplants – mainly at nearby Children's Hospital and Shriner's Hospital.

The apartments are arranged so that sofas and tables outside the doors of each two apartments allow families from all over the globe to meet and share their experiences. The kitchens are built to encourage people to meet and talk while they are preparing their meals for themselves. Regarding cost, families are only asked to pay \$25 a day IF they can afford to do so, or else to pay what they can. No one is turned away for lack of payment. Telephones in the lobbies are available to the

families, and if they speak a foreign language, a translator comes on the line and translates what is being said.



The transplant patients are given apartments in a special transplant wing that have kitchenettes so the children who must be kept in isolation can

still be with their parents all the time. Our docent, Amy, has a full time job during the week but, for 20 years,



she has come to volunteer at RMH wherever needed on weekends. She showed us where the Trail Duster Square Dance Club was mentioned on the walls in several rooms. Our club also made possible a children's library that has books in various languages which the children are allowed to take home with them. We visited several playrooms with toys and crafts



geared to various age groups. RMH even had some movie

studios come and paint backdrops to make each playroom a happy place for children to spend time.

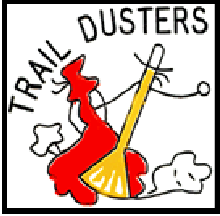

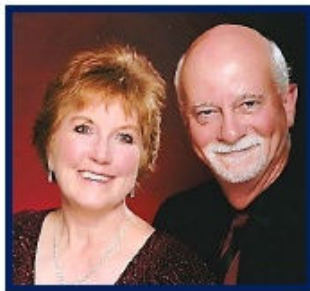

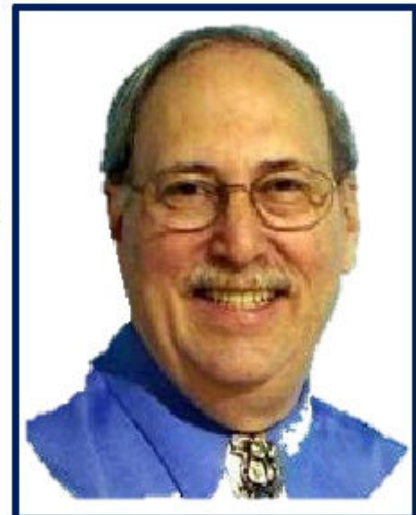

Thank you for your incredible donation of essential items – specifically over 75 sheets sets, 150 sets of bath and hand towels, as well as plenty of food items for the pantry. Because of your generosity, families will now have clean, untattered bed sheets, fresh towels, and plenty of meal and snack options that every family deserves to have in their "home."

The Los Angeles Ronald McDonald House is a "Home Away from Home" for more than 2,100 families every year. For more than 35 years, the House has provided more than 30,000 families with a place to stay, a shoulder to cry on, and when necessary the financial support that they have needed to make it through a very uncertain time.

Our House has 75 rooms and we are at full occupancy with a long waiting list. Currently, more than 70% of our families cannot even afford the \$25 per night to stay at our House.
