Clarence H. Steinman, age 89, of Caseville, passed away Saturday, July 11 at Scheurer Hospital, Pigeon.

He was born March 29, 1898 in Chandler Township, son of the late Henry and Minnie (Kleinhardt) Steinman. On December 24, 1919 he was united in marriage to Jessie Beadle.
