

Former President Of Elevator Firm Dies

Herman E. Henne, 75, prominent Bay Port resident and former president of Wallace and Morley Elevator Company, died Wednesday afternoon, September 6, in Scheurer Hospital, Pigeon, following a short illness.

He was born April 26, 1886, in Fair Haven township, Huron county.

He served as general manager of Wallace and Morley Co. from 1915 to 1948 when he was elected president. He retired in 1959.

A past president of the National Bean Council, he was also a past president of the Michigan Bean Shippers Association. He was an active community worker and an active member of the Bay Port Methodist church.

In January of 1905, he was married to Kathleen Collen. She died in 1950. In 1957 he married Nellie N. Judkins.

Surviving are his widow; seven daughters, Mrs. Stanley Treat, Elida, Ohio, Mrs. Harry Sullivan, Mrs. Samuel Anker, and Mrs. Robert Wooley, all of Mt. Pleasant, Mrs. Edward Jerome, Midland, Mrs. Roland Kuhl, Berkley and Mrs. John Hatley, Allen Park; two sons, James of Cadillac and Ralph of Bay Port; 25 grandchildren; two great grandchildren; a sister, Mrs. Jacob Schwalm, Caseville and five brothers, Samuel Saginaw, Arthur, William and Victor, all of Bay Port, and Gerald, Pigeon.

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Sunday in the Bay Port Methodist church. The Rev. Richard A. Turner, pastor, and the Rev. Perce Woodruff, former pastor, officiated. Burial was in the New Bay Port cemetery.
