

Field & Stream Trap Shooting Rules

First squad starts at 8:30 a.m

Recognized rules and etiquette of Trap Shooting will be observed:

- All shooters must have a signed Insurance Waiver form on file. (minimum 12 yr old or Hunter Ed graduate)
- Any shooter found handling firearms in an unsafe manner will be given a chance to act safely. If not, the shooter will be asked to leave the club grounds.
- When signing in, please write "open" after your name if it is not going to be a league shoot. (Please do this before shooting that round, NO changing after the round is shot)
- When shooting multiple rounds please sign up every other round to allow others to shoot at a reasonable time.
- Please try not to be more than three shooting weeks behind. (For current weekly scoring)
- When your squad number comes up, please be at the marking house and ready to shoot.
- Refrain from loud noises in the shooting area while a round is in progress.
- Only normal and recognized trap shooting shells may be used during league shoots.
 - Shooters are responsible for the pickup of their empty hulls after each round is completed.
 - Take all your empty hulls with you for disposal when you leave the club.
- Any questions over miscalled or missed targets must be resolved before switching stations.

(A review from all shooters on line may be requested)

- ALL shooters, markers, and trap pullers must wear appropriate eye and hearing protection while in the area of active shooting.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES:

The consumption of alcoholic beverages is discouraged before and while you are actively shooting.
