We are excited to close out our 9th season in style with a trip back to Panther Creek! This property is MASSIVE and the possibilities are limitless! Each year we've added in some new trail here and there and we hosted the Off-Road Cup at this location in 2018.

Panther Creek is typical of most Missouri tracks, meaning it's fairly rocky and gravelly and it can handle moisture. In fact, much of the course is "better when wet". Additional track info will be added later today (if Steve sends me anything new)!

The start/finish/scoring stuff is the same location as usual. We've got some super sweet ups & downs, cool ravines and creek beds, a couple logging roads, and heaps of single-track. Added trail over the weekend and some more last night so we are at 20 miles now...how awesome is THAT??!!!!

The 65/85/Ladies tracks will utilize the same sweet trails that we have used in the past. Those courses are mostly single track with some field sections linking them together. To keep it exciting and just a little bit challenging, there will be an uphill/downhill or two. It's the same track, just in reverse from 2018.

The 50 track is rider friendly and completely separate from all other courses! It is virtually all flat and the least rocky of anything on the property.

- No practice
- Start time is 10:30 am
- Course will be 20 miles long (our longest course ever)
- All classes race at the same time
- Short Course classes run 2 laps
- Long Course classes run 3 laps

Be sure that you go signup BEFORE you go out to practice – we have Dunlop certificates for the first 150 through Sign-Up (\$20 off 1 tire or \$40 off 2)! Please come to the riders' meeting(s) – PLEASE respect the property & NO riding after dark.
