

Good morning!

Post play.....it can be physical and the opponents can be leaning on each other. We still have the 'freedom of movement' rules when a post player receives the ball. Take a look at the post play clip [here](#).

Whistle? If so, on the offense correct? We need to ask ourselves 'what did the defense do wrong?' Nothing! We either have a no-call or a foul on the offense (holding most likely). The defender simply moved back when white received the ball.

Lead should have had a good look at this as it was his primary matchup that was happening. It also seems L was in a good position to see 'between' the players and SEE that white was holding red from getting around at all. L is just out of the camera angle and I assume he wasn't sitting in a chair on the sideline! Sometimes defenders get penalized unfairly on plays such as these. If we are in good position to see the play develop and finish, play-calling is easier and we can give a good explanation to a coach, should we be asked.

Extra: Do not be afraid to ask table personnel to find a bottle of hand sanitizer to be located at the table.....and to go use it when at timeouts.
