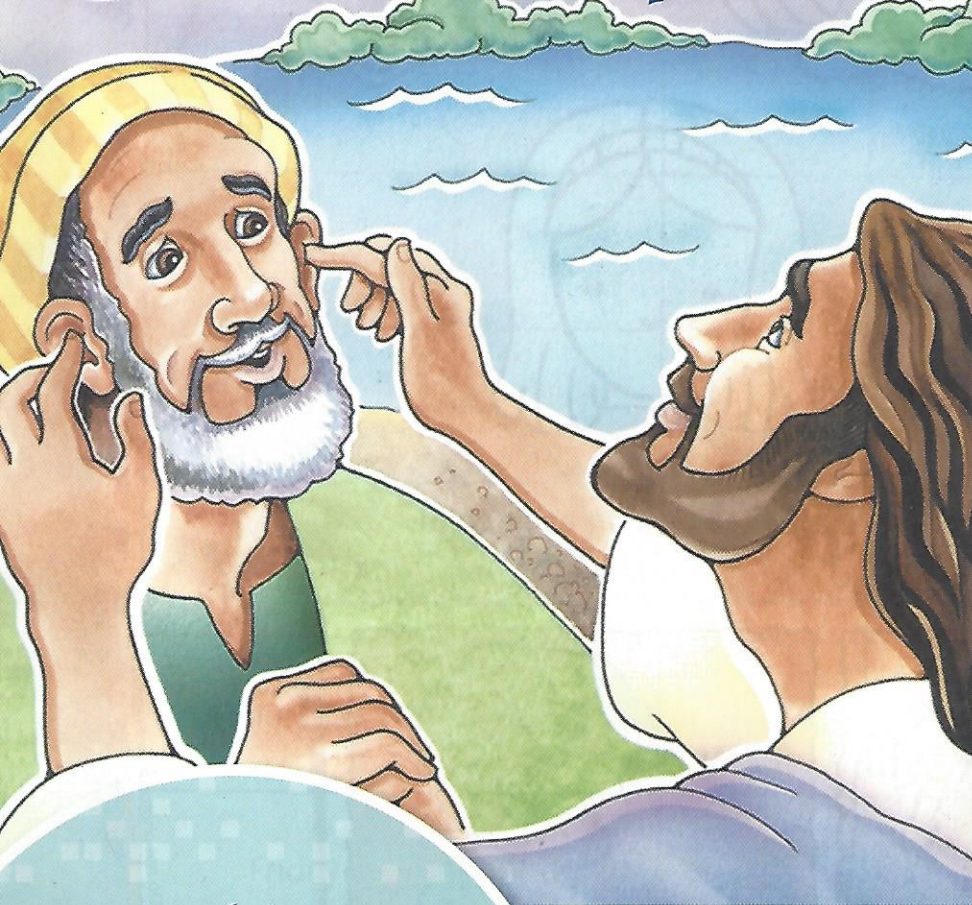

Jesus healed a man who could not do what two things?

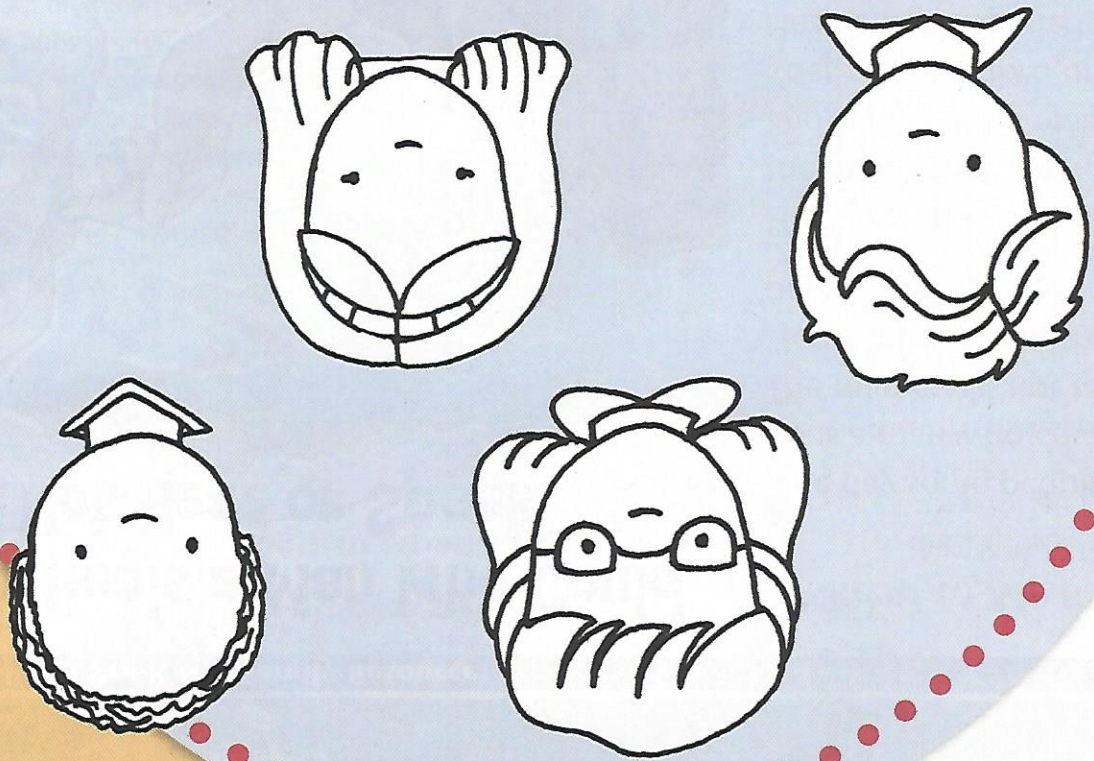
What did the people say about Jesus?



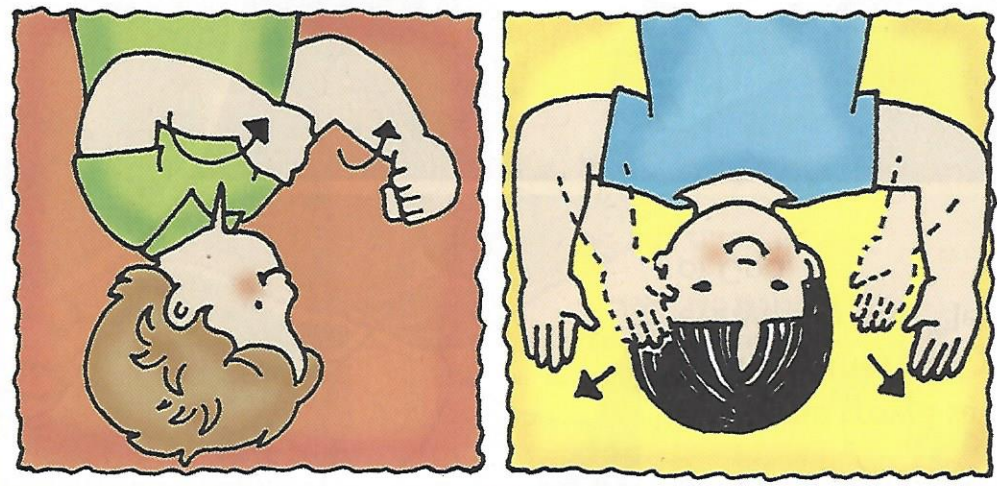


Finish the Faces

Then color the faces.








Show the signs for great and powerful. Tell Jesus how wonderful He is.

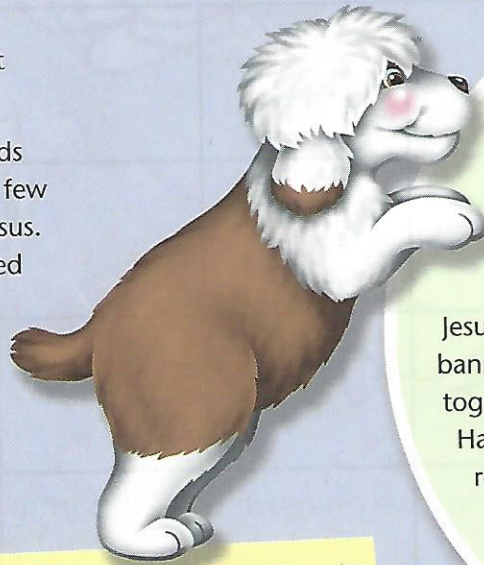
Bible Memory FUN
