## 2019 MAYBERRY FARM FEST RULES

The area covered by this event is restricted. There may not be enough room for all applicants.

Acceptance in this event will be determined by representatives of the Mount Airy Downtown Business Association(DBA) in accordance with their judgment as to what is best for the event. The sooner your application is turned in, the better chance you have of being approved.

The assignment of street locations for event participants will be based on the needs of the event and on the needs of the participant.

Each vendor is responsible for his/her own sales and the collection of sales tax.

Each vendor and exhibitor must supply all the set-up needs for his/her tent, and is responsible for making sure the tent/booth is stable and secure against wind, rain, and crowds. Each booth will be inspected for safety by the Mount Airy Fire Department.

Each vendor and exhibitor is responsible for his/her possessions. The organizers and executors of the event are not responsible for theft, damage, or injury.

Items for sale by vendors must be approved by the DBA. This is a family-oriented event, with children welcome and encouraged to attend. .

All food vendors will be inspected by the Health Department.

Applicable entry fees must accompany applications, and they are non-refundable, unless the application is rejected, in which case the fee will be returned.

Farm Fest is scheduled to take place rain or shine. No refunds will be issued.

### **EVENT INSTRUCTIONS:**

**FRIDAY, May 17: PARADE PARTICIPANTS TO ASSEMBLE IN LOWER PARKING LOT ON FRANKLIN STREET BY 5PM. PARADE TO BEGIN AT 6PM. AFTER PARADE, EXHIBITORS CAN CLAIM THEIR ASSIGNED SPOTS ON MAIN STREET.**

**THE KIDS RIDE-ON PARADE WILL TAKE PLACE IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE TRACTOR PARADE. KIDS AND PARENTS MEET IN THE PARKING LOT AT THE CORNER OF MAIN AND OAK STREET BY 5:45. KIDS CAN WALK, RIDE BIKES, OR DRIVE RIDE-ON TOYS IN THE KIDS PARADE. PARENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CHAPERONING THEIR CHILDREN IN THE PARADE IF NECESSARY.**

**SATURDAY, May 18: ALL EXHIBITS TO BE IN PLACE AND ALL BOOTHS TO BE OPERATIONAL BY 8:30AM. EVENT WILL OPEN AT 9AM AND CLOSE AT 6PM.
