THE VENUE The Greater Philadelphia Expo Center is a former home of the B. F. Goodrich Tire and Rubber Company. From 1937 to 1986 Goodrich produced as many as 12,000 automobile tires per day in its Oaks plant.

The privately owned facility was renovated and converted to multiple retail and service related businesses. One entire building is now the 240,000 sq. ft. single story Expo Center with 5,000 dedicated free parking spaces. The Expo Center hosts 100's of events and boasts over 1 million visitors annually.

Within the same complex and nearby you will find hotels, restaurants, banks, gas stations, Lowe's, Target, a multi-screen theater and much more. The King of Prussia Mall is just minutes away as are Valley Forge National Park and the Valley Forge Casino Resort.

It's a convenient thirty minute drive to Philadelphia with its multitude of attractions including Penn's Landing, the Philadelphia Zoo, Museum of Art, Franklin Institute, Academy of Natural Sciences, Boathouse Row, Barnes Foundation, Reading Terminal Market, Please Touch Museum, Kimmel Center, China Town, Independence Hall and a host of other historic sites.
