AN ENRICHING SUMMER RESEARCH PROGRAM that provides junior faculty with didactic courses in health disparities, diversity, study design, working with and presenting data, research ethics, grantsmanship skills and academic career development.



PROGRAM DETAILS

- Two Year Training Program 2022-2023
- Summer 1: Two weeks (June 6-17, 2022)
- Summer 2: June 2023
- Up to \$20,000 can be used for Research support, research training, and courses.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Underrepresented individuals in biomedical, clinical, behavioral, and social sciences. These groups include: Blacks or African Americans, Hispanics or Latinos, American Indians or Alaska Natives, Native Hawaiians and other Pacific Islanders, Individuals with disabilities, Individuals from disadvantaged backgrounds, and Women. Must be a US Citizen or Legal Resident.
