

## **GIRLS AND BOYS GOLF**

### **5.0 GOVERNING RULES**

USGA rules and home course rules are to be followed.

### **5.1 CONTACTS**

The Sac-Joaquin Section (Bylaw 505.2) will determine the maximum number of allowable contests. Scrimmages for all levels are limited to two per team

### **5.2 START DATE**

Girls: The start and end dates will be designated by the CIF Sac-Joaquin Section.

Boys: The start and end dates will be designated by the CIF Sac-Joaquin Section.

### **5.3 PLAYER CLASSIFICATION**

All players compete at the varsity level.

### **5.4 RULES OF THE SPORT-**

A. The home/host team must report the final results to the Metro League rep.

B. The Metro League will play a single round 9 hole schedule with two 18 hole league tournaments.

C. Schools will use a six (6) person team, and will follow CIF scoring rules; medal play, low 5 out of 6 scores count in determining the match winner. Caddies are not allowed. Players must carry their own golf bags unless they choose to use a pull cart.

D. If seen by an official or coach, a two stroke penalty for throwing clubs will be assessed per infraction. All infractions must be brought by a coach or official to the attention of the host school's coach following the end of the match or tournament.

E. The league champion will be determined as follows : Teams will earn one point for each dual match win, one half point for each tie, zero points for a loss, and one point for each team they defeat in the two league tournaments. League tournament points will be awarded with all ties broken by using the #6 players score, then with a sudden-death extra hole(s) between the tied teams. The team with the most total points will be Metro League Champion.

F. Approved range finders may be used in accordance with Sac-Joaquin Section rules.

G. A score of double par plus one will be the maximum score on a hole.

### **5.5 ALL LEAGUE AWARDS AND SELECTION PROCESS**

All League will be determined by points earned during both the dual matches and the League tournaments. The player with the most points will be the Player of the Year and the next 6 players will be All League.

### **5.6 POST-SEASON QUALIFICATION PROCEDURE**

Qualification for post-season play is determined by the Sac-Joaquin Section
