True Wealth And The Silent Revolution

It is a truism that all true wealth available to us comes from the planet we call Earth. That wealth is in the ground under us, the atmosphere above us, and all of the waters, wherever it is found. All of that is sustained by the sun.

God, by way of creation, requires that we have an ample supply of all four of those components of true wealth for our survival. He created the entire system to be in perfect balance e.g., ground, water, atmosphere and sun. Ground, without the sun, water and atmosphere, cannot grow the plants we need for food. The atmosphere, without the green plants coming from the ground, cannot replenish itself with oxygen.

The waters of the oceans, heated by the sun, create clouds containing pure water, which moves over the land. The green plants excite the clouds causing rain. The rain forms the lakes, rivers, ground water and springs.

All is in perfect balance and we are truly wealthy in the genuine sense. We are wealthy, that is, if we obey God's Commandments. If we disobey God's Commandments He causes an imbalance in those four elements of wealth and we are in trouble with droughts, floods, insect infestations, diseases, etc.

[Isaiah tells us in Chapter 55, starting with verse 8:](#) *"For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the Lord. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts. "*

"For as the rain cometh down, and the snow from heaven, and returneth not thither, but watereth the earth, and maketh it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater: So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it. "

"For ye shall go out with joy, and be led forth with peace: the mountains and the hills shall break forth before you into singing, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands. Instead of the thorn shall come up the fir tree, and instead of the brier shall come up the myrtle tree: and it shall be to the Lord for a name, for an everlasting sign that shall not be cut off. " ([Isaiah 55: 8-13](#)).

The enemies of Christ, the antichrists of [1 John 2:18](#), know those verses of [Isaiah 55](#) better than do most Judeo-Christians. That is because most Judeo-Christians don't read the Old Testament and those who do, don't believe what it says!

All of us are repeatedly told to keep quiet, not to object to anything government does because it is for our own good ([Romans 13: 1-7](#)). That is only true if we have a Godly government. It becomes untrue the moment we have an ungodly government.

On the other side of the world, the Fabian Socialists of the British Empire were also Bolsheviks. They just didn't call themselves that. We have in past issues shown that Oliver Cromwell and Rabbi Mannaseh ben Israel formed an alliance wherein the agreement was made that, "With a marriage between Jewish money and British nobility, together we will rule the world." From that marriage came the Fabian Socialists.

Through the centuries, another "marriage" was formed between the Fabian Socialists of the British Empire and the Bolsheviks of Russia. The United States became a part of that marriage with the advent of Cecil Rhodes' Knights of the Round Table and the U.S. Council of Foreign Relations. With money from the United States, Russian Jews created Bolshevik Russia. It was Judeo-Christians of England who created Fabian Socialism. It was Judeo-Christians of England and the United States who created that mini-state in the Mideast called Israel (sic). All of this has been authoritatively documented in past issues of the *Intelligence Newsletter*. However, we do not have the individual articles catalogued for easy retrieval.

We have also, in issues past, shown examples of the great silent revolution going on within our existence today. We have shown the effects of the [United Nations \(UN\)](#), the [World Trade Organization \(WTO\)](#), the [North American Free Trade Agreement \(NAFTA\)](#), etc. Each of these were created by treaty action by our government. These treaties are un-American and ungodly. So much for the manner most Judeo-Christians understand [Romans 13:1](#).

Each and every one of these treaties has manipulated the true wealth of the earth and has placed it in the hands of an elite few. This has been accomplished while they undoubtedly understand the implications of [Isaiah 55: 8-13](#).

There have been many instances where the wealth of one person has been unlawfully taken by another. We have courts of law to handle most of these cases, unless it is in keeping with the greater theft of the natural wealth of all of us. This is the situation in which we find ourselves today. This is the subject of this issue of the *Intelligence Newsletter*. This great theft of the natural wealth is being described by our Bolsheviks as being to the best interest of all of us.

They have, or are, taking the natural wealth of the ground. Mines are now out of reach of the average small miner. The richer ore bodies of our mountains have been removed from access because most of them are converted to "Wilderness Areas" or "Primitive Areas" with no access roads.

The Timber Industry is a dying industry and we have discussed it in several issues. There are many brave souls who are fighting this beast and in some instances winning. But

the very access to the forests of the United States is slowly being removed from the "lowly citizen."

The "vacant lands," mostly in the Western states, are lawfully owned by the people of the United States. However, they are classified as "government property" and access can be denied partly or completely from the citizen by bureaucrats by regulation. As a result, the American rancher is slowly being removed from lands which have been an American heritage for over 200 years.

The same situation exists within the fishing industries. Independent American fishermen are being regulated out of business.

The "backbone" of our country's food source is the American farmer. His genius and creativity in the development of farming techniques and implements have made him the leader of the world. Truly, the American farmer has set the pace for the production of sufficient food for the entire world. But this has been with a price. The American farmer has been unknowingly used by the silent revolution.

Some years ago, a consortium of governmental, industrial, banking and educational organizations combined to teach the American farmer a new concept of farming. This new method would substantially increase his production and, therefore, his profits. The United States government had, at an earlier date, created the "State College" concept. The government would provide the land for a college, to be in each state, along with money for assistance. This, to the best of our knowledge currently, was for the best education possible of the American farmer. This system worked amazingly well for many years.

In more recent years, however, the silent revolution gathered at the doors of these colleges with a program which would drastically change and eventually destroy the American family system of farming. The big oil companies came with artificial fertilizers, chemical insecticides, plant growth enhancers, etc. The big industrial giants came with enormous tractors, combines, and other implements which would enable the farmer to operate many more times the acreage. The banks came with enticing financing packages. The farmer was told by the banker to buy all the land he wanted and farm it from fence line to fence line. All of this would be at such attractive interest rates that any farmer, with a modicum of experience, could become a millionaire.

The oil companies gave to the Agriculture Department of the colleges huge samples of their fertilizers, insecticides and other chemicals and were told, "Try them, you will like them!" The industrial giants introduced the colleges to the new, powerful machinery. The banks went to the colleges and taught the Economics Departments of these state colleges how the banks would cooperate. The government turned a blind eye and a deaf ear!

The seed companies developed new strains of seed which were hybrid. They wouldn't reproduce true if the farmer saved some of his crop and replanted the seed. They then developed "terminator" seeds which had to be planted the same year of purchase because the seeds were developed with a specific, short life span.

Other chemical companies developed "growth enhancers" such as estrogen based hormones which forced cows to give more milk. Then came the Bovine Growth Hormone (BGH) which also increased milk production. These came with a price, also. They caused our young' girls to develop into womanhood much earlier with the attendant difficulties for parents.

The farmers, most unfortunately, bought it. They sent their sons to these colleges to learn of these new concepts. God's laws on land rest, rotation, non-hybrid seeds, and

natural fertilizers were forgotten. The land lost the richness of the health-giving elements God's system provided.


In due time, there were financial troubles "down on the farm." Farm after farm went bankrupt and farmers from many generations of farmers had to go to the big city to get jobs. Throughout the "breadbasket" of America these farms were sold to the highest bidder at the court house steps. In stepped the corporations which had been funded to the hilt. It is so sad to know that many of those corporate farms are now managed by the families who had earlier owned them!

Again, the silent revolution has been hard at work. The American family farm is rapidly becoming a thing of the past. Many of those farms which had not been taken by corporations were lost to other causes. Some of the land is losing its water source. Some of it is being gobbled up by city sprawl. Some is being changed into wildlife refuges. Some is being returned to so-called "wetlands."

All of these actions on the part of this country's "obligations" to treaties is causing the land to simply be removed from use. The families who developed all of these works have simply been removed and replaced by moneyed interests with other purposes. Nearly all of them have used the ruse of "environmentalism" as their justification. We are referring to organizations such as "Nature Conservancy, Ted Turner's "empire", Sierra Club and Earth First, along with many others.

Now, let us go one step further. Suppose those of the "silent revolution" have developed techniques to substantially change the environment. This, in turn, would create a need for changes in the minds of many, if not most, American citizens in the way the nation's basic natural wealth was to be managed. They did just that and we have reported it in past issues.

If the third basic component, water, which God created for a balanced environment is caused to be in imbalance, all of the peoples of the world will demand a change in the system. It is water, simple H₂O, which is now being used in an attempt to place us all in bondage to the world's revolutionaries. If they succeed, in just a very few years we will all be paying dearly just for a glass of water to drink! In fact, it is already being done in some parts of the world. If they can't pay, they die! We will use the remainder of this issue to explain it.

In the 1930's, Nicola Tesla conducted some experiments in Colorado and elsewhere which proved that the earth's stratosphere, atmosphere and the earth itself are materially affected when bombarded with certain electrical signals. He satisfactorily proved that the weather can be modified as well.

He obtained patents on these experiments and they rested in the U.S. Patent Office for years. Such information was of the utmost importance but for ulterior reasons or sheer ignorance, the patents were never classified. The Russians easily obtained them and continued with Tesla's works.

Starting in the 1980's, the United States Government, utilizing the patents and scientific expertise of [Bernard J. Eastlund](#), created another monster which, by Eastlund's own words, causes weather modification. Of course, this is in addition to many, many other ulterior purposes. The project called [High-frequency Active Auroral Research Program](#) (HAARP) was constructed in

Alaska. This was used for many purposes, all of which significantly and dangerously modified the earth's atmosphere. The protective Ozone layer was materially decreased in these experiments but to cover their complicity they want to blame the use of certain refrigerants!

At the same time, International Treaties were made which restricted one country from causing weather modification in another country. Any program to be implemented in one country must get the approval of the adjacent country. These treaties, alone, would tell any reasonable person that, if there need to be treaties on the matter, then the capability exists!

Weather modification experiments, or concerted programs, created by [HAARP](#) are causing serious changes in weather patterns. It is most unusual, for example, for the States of Washington, Oregon, Idaho and Florida to be in the current severe drought conditions. In most past years, the winter months, particularly in Washington and Oregon, have notoriously been extremely wet. The snow packs in these three states have always been able to provide the rivers of the Northwest with irrigation water as well as hydroelectric power. There is a drought of enormous proportions in that area this year. That is just one example.

At the same time, other parts of the country are experiencing unusually wet and cold weather. This condition seems to be constantly changing from year to year. All of this leaves our water supply in critical condition.

During this same time period, the Federal Government has been attempting to acquire the water rights on all of the lands of the West. Their reasoning is that most of the water in the western states originates in the snow packs of the mountains. The ownership of the mountainous lands of the West has, almost exclusively, been retained by the Federal Government.

This, in itself, has been basically for ulterior purposes. The western mountains are a legendary wealth of natural resources which comprise the basic elements of true wealth. The lumber comes from the renewable trees. A fabulous wealth of minerals comes from the ground. The earth itself is of untold value for the production of foodstuffs, mainly meat. The water, coming from the yearly snow packs, drives the hydroelectric power plants and the dams provide lakes for fish to be used for food by the citizens. That water provides the irrigation for the best organized and operated grain, vegetable, nut, and fruit farms in the world.

The system for adjudicating the usage of that water has been developed over many years and the results have also been a model for the world to see. As long as outside forces are not allowed to enter into the delicate balance, there has been enough water for everyone concerned. Only when outside influences with their own agenda come in and demands changes in order to meet their own selfish requirements, problems arise. Those are the circumstances which confront the western states today.

To enhance, yes, enhance, the problems, the Federal Government has now initiated a test case in Federal Court in Cibola County, New Mexico to acquire all of the water rights in the county. Now consider this: Cibola County is a remote, sparsely populated county, inhabited mostly with American Indians who, in the main, do not operate the land, along with a comparatively few cattle ranchers and small irrigated farms.

The decision to test the entire water rights situation in the entire west in this little, insignificant, county should tell us a story in itself. We should all be appraised of this most important situation. We should enter into the contest because the outcome should tell us

who will supply us our water for personal consumption and at what price we pay. This should be obvious after you conclude this issue!

Our first source of information comes from an article found in the *Free American Newsmagazine*, Box 2943, Bingham, NM 87832. We will reproduce it for you in its entirety:

Our New Resource Crisis. By Peter Phillips.

"Imagine, that we are beyond the energy crisis-in that we are used to paying double or triple prices for what in the previous century was a small part of the family budget. But now we are faced with a new shortage that taps another precious resource. Water only comes through the tap four hours a day and we are forced to pay ten to hundred times what we paid in the 90's. Welcome to the world of privatized water, where fresh water is treated like a commodity, traded and sold in the international market to the highest bidder.

"No longer can you assume a God-given right to drink from a mountain spring, but instead you will have to pay a toll to drink from Enron Springs, Monsanto Wells or receive tap water from Bechtel Water Works. Global consumption of water is doubling every 20 years, more than twice the rate of human population growth. According to the United Nations, more than one billion people already lack access to fresh drinking water. If current trends persist, by 2025 the demand for fresh water is expected to rise by 56 percent more than the amount of water that is currently available. Multinational corporations recognize these trends and are trying to monopolize water supplies around the world. Monsanto, Bechtel, Enron and other global multinationals are seeking control of world water systems and supplies.

"The World Bank recently adopted a policy of water privatization and full-cost water pricing. This policy is causing great distress in many Third World countries, which fear that their citizens will not be able to affront for-profit water.

"Last year in a little known case of high scale international water marketing, a supertanker was reported to have filled up with water from Lake Erie and after paying the Canadian Government they shipped the water to Southeast Asia. Maude Barlow, Chair of the Council of Canadians, Canada's largest public advocacy group, states, 'Governments around the world must act now to declare water a fundamental human right and prevent efforts to privatize, export, and sell for profit a substance essential to all life. Research has shown that selling water on the open market only delivers it to wealthy cities and individuals. The finite sources of fresh water (less than one half of one percent of the world's total water stock) are being diverted, depleted, and polluted so fast that, by the year 2025, two-thirds of the world's population will be living in a state of serious water deprivation.' Governments are signing away their control over domestic water supplies by participating in trade treaties such as the [North American Free Trade Agreement \(NAFTA\)](#) and in institutions such as the [World Trade Organization \(WTO\)](#). These agreements give transnational corporations the unprecedented right to the water of signatory companies.

"Monsanto plans to earn revenues of \$420 million and a net income of \$63 million by 2008 from its water business in India and Mexico. Monsanto estimates that water will become a multibillion-dollar market in the coming decades."

From that article alone we can readily realize that the privatization of water is a global project organized by the [United Nations](#), [NAFTA](#), [The World Bank](#), and many multinational corporations which are Non Government Organizations but hold tremendous influence in government actions. Corporations listed are: [Bechtel Corp.](#), [Monsanto Chemical Corp.](#), and Enron Corp.

Mr. Phillip's article is about the privatization of the ownership, the delivery systems and the selling of water to the entire world. Should we shrug off this program as being totally unworkable, a pipe-dream perhaps? Or, is it possible that our children, and their children, will live in such a nightmare?

In reality, this water program is just one of many such programs which the controllers and owners of the United Nations have in progress for us! It is but one program within what is termed "Agenda 21." The term Agenda 21 comes from their goal of obtaining full sovereignty of the entire world by the end of the 21st century. That goal comes from the plan originated by Cecil Rhodes in the 1890's. His plan was that the English speaking peoples of the world would be sovereign over the entire world within 200 years. That meant that by the year 2100 his plan would be complete.

The plan remained intact with the goal still being that the world order would be in place by the end of the year 2100. However, it was abrogated to an even more powerful entity known as Bolshevism, that mysterious blend of high finances, Judeo-Christians, Zionist Jews, atheists, multi-national corporations and the universities.

[Agenda 21](#) is simply the program for the 21 century, that final 100 years before they intend to see their Zionist Utopia. **We here at Christian Crusade for Truth have no doubt whatsoever that they will miserably fail to reach their goal!** But, God in all of His Omnipotence is going to give us a rough ride for the near future, simply because we have failed Him!

We will find the numbers 21 in many of the [United Nations](#) programs. Border XXI is a United Nations program for the border region between Mexico and the United States. All of these programs concern themselves with those four basic components of true wealth which God has created for us. This was discussed in the first part of this issue. Certainly, they all include water as one component.

We found a very interesting and revealing treatise on this global water grab in the publication by Susan Bryce, publisher/editor of the *Australian Freedom & Survival Guide*, PO Box 66, Kenilworth, Qld 4574, Australia. The publication's information came from numerous

United Nations sources. We will be extracting information from her article as we proceed with this issue of the *Intelligence Newsletter*.

The [World Water Council](#), created in 1996 by the U.N. is considered a "private think-tank." It isn't "private" because it is made up of primarily United Nations organizations. It isn't a "think-tank" either because they think only what they are told to think and do only what they are told to do, all in perfect lockstep with their masters!

The [World Water Council](#) calmly went about developing a system which would eventually take control of the entire world's water supply. They developed what they termed a "long term vision" which would become known as "World Water Vision, Making Water Everybody's Business." That is intended to mean that the water supply of the entire world would be put on a business foundation, to be sold for profit by the Bolshevik elite.

Four thousand selected "visionary" water "experts" met at the Hague in March, 2000 with the intentions of getting multi-national corporations involved in "integrated water resources management." Attached to that statement was this intention, "to ensure that every person has access to enough safe water at an affordable cost." Their overall agenda was this, "Valuing water: to manage water in a way that reflects its economic, social, environmental and cultural values for all its uses, and to move towards pricing water services to reflect the cost of their provision."

In keeping with the true intent of this Bolshevik capitalism, this meeting was specifically for multinational corporations and was designed specifically for economic profit by these huge corporations. Their charter was one of greed and reflects the tribulations to come within the world's farming system which uses water for irrigation of food for the world's people to eat. Here is that charter: "Water is an economic good and its economic value should be recognized in the allocation of scarce water resources to competing uses. While this should not prevent people from meeting their basic needs for water services at affordable prices, the price for water must be set at a level that encourages conservation and wise use."

In reality these Bolsheviks are getting into the "conservation" of water at a very late date. For many years now, we all can see the results of a sane, reasonable, equitable and workable water conservation program already in place in this country. We don't need some Bolshevik confiscating our nation's water supply and turning it over to some multinational to make a profit from what would become our people's misery.

We constantly see city water services placing short informational pieces on TV and radio showing how to save water. We see the redesign of toilets which use considerably less water. We see farmers who are undertaking the total redesign of their irrigation systems which use a newly invented underground "drip" system for large fields. The system is a vast improvement in water management. We see commercial automobile wash systems which recycle the wash water with an enormous savings of water- much above that of personal car washing at home! There are restaurants who give drinking water only when asked for it. The list goes on and on. We don't need these Bolsheviks coming in to confiscate all of this infrastructure for them to make a profit from it.

This writer remembers very well the water supply situation in France during World War II. "Safe" drinking water, as we have known it in this country for well over a century, is unknown in many parts of France, particularly in the rural areas. It was obvious why the French people preferred to drink wine at their meals. The alcohol purified the water and thus the wine was safe to drink!

When the U.S. Army entered into France, we took with us water purification plants. The plants were comparatively small and movable, being made of canvas tanks held upright with wooden stays. There was the small purification system, driven by pumps. The French people watched the pumping of water from stagnant ponds and polluted streams and being purified right before their eyes! They simply couldn't believe that we could do that and drink it without ever becoming sick.

The world is full of water in that exact situation. It is polluted and can't be used in its current form. If these Bolsheviks really wanted to do something good for the people of the world, they could make available such small portable plants. The technology undoubtedly has vastly improved since World War II.

Their "doublespeak" is astounding. They write in their "visions" in a way that would show their philanthropic graciousness. However their true evil shows through these futuristic writings for those today of whom Jesus spoke in [Matthew 13:16](#), "*But blessed are your eyes, for they see: and your ears, for they hear.* "

Their "vision," writing in the year 2025 reads thusly: "By 2010, public and private utilities were generally applying full cost recovery. Because some low-income households could not afford water, measures were introduced to subsidize these households so that they could pay for water to meet their basic needs. These households also contributed to the cost of their services in kind through their labor for installation and operation."

This sounds noble enough but the hearts of mankind are hard, especially when one considers the past record of the Bolsheviks. We saw the peasant class in action in Russia. We saw the peasant class in China.

Of course, the World Bank is a part of the action. They have already made the assessment that the wars of the 21st century will be over the water issue. That could very well be an astute observation! But, of course, they, are in the business of making money through usury. This is their policy which they developed in 1992 for the intended great water grab. "Charging fees for domestic and industrial water supplies is generally straightforward. In most cases, use can be metered and fees can be charged according to the volume and reliability of water used. Economic efficiency would be obtained by setting water charges equal to the opportunity cost of water. However, immediate adoption of such prices often proves to be politically difficult. Thus, given the low level of cost recovery at present and the extent of underpricing, fees that establish the water entity's financial autonomy would be a good starting point to ensure the entity's independence and the sustainability of operations. Both public and private entities should pay for the costs of the water and sanitation services they receive."

We must remember, the United States Government funds the World Bank and the International Monetary Fund (IMF). This means that the taxes of United States citizens funds these banking institutions. From the book *Socialism: The Road to Slavery* by Dr. John Coleman we can read this about the IMF. "Like so many of the One World Government institutions, the IMF was simply a vehicle for draining money from the American economy and farming it out to countries that had excellent natural resources as collateral. What the unwary governments did not know, and indeed, had no way of knowing, was that the IMF would not only abscond with their natural resources, but also control and then destroy their national sovereignty. Rhodesia, the Philippines, Angola, Brazil are good examples of what happens when the IMF is let in." He says this about the World Bank, "Today, our membership of the World Bank, the Bank of International Settlements and our willingness - to compromise our sovereignty by falling in line with the dictates of the International

Monetary Fund (IMF) bodes ill for the future and would indicate that the Committee of 300 is gearing up for another world war."

Now we can explain how the World Bank is operating with respect to this world water grab. Susan Bryce writes this in her publication, "Apart from its funding to support water privatization, the World Bank is the world's greatest single source of funds for large dam construction, having provided more than US \$50 billion for construction of more than 500 large dams in 92 countries."

The United State's citizens help fund the World Bank, the IMF and the Bank of International Settlements. These tax dollars are then used by the World Bank to build huge hydroelectric dams in at least 92 foreign countries. The World Bank then establishes private water works companies to sell the water to the poor citizens of these mostly Third-World countries.

This "slight-of-hand" trick continues. The World Bank funds the privatization of the distribution of the water which is impounded behind dams paid for by the U.S. citizens. There is a return made from usury in these transactions. Further, the funding by the United States of these organizations is unconstitutional. Here is what Dr. John Coleman writes about it, "Nowhere in the Constitution is there found a power that authorizes the United States Government to fund so-called international banks like the World Bank and the IMF. We have no constitutional power authorizing the funding of foreign banks, hence such action is unlawful."

God gave us very basic, but extremely important, instructions on the manner in which we would grow our food crops. He gave us explicit instructions on the resting of land, that seeds must not be hybridized. We are to use natural fertilizers and not something created in a laboratory out of oil. When we fail to heed those laws we suffer.

We, as a nation, are a sick people. We eat enormous amounts of food but we are starving, simply because the food we eat no longer contains the nutrients. Our immune systems are not working because we are not eating nutritious foods. All of this is because we have failed God's laws on how we should grow food.

It is not questioned that the hybrid seeds and the commercial fertilizers increase yields. It is not questioned that a tremendous number of people can be fed throughout the world using these techniques. But is that what our loving God really intended? **Not only is our God the greatest of all Geneticists, He is the greatest expert in population control! Mankind reproduces in direct proportion to the food available to eat.**

Starting in the 1970's nearly the entire world experienced what became known as "The Green Revolution." The agrochemical corporations were encouraged to develop seeds which gave extremely high yields. There were new strains of corn, rice, maize and other basic food crops developed. But that development came with a price. They required large amounts of inorganic fertilizers. They required a much larger amount of water to complement that inorganic fertilizer.

Currently, nearly 70% of the world's available fresh water is used for irrigation to feed this monster! Now, the agrochemical companies have changed from the fertilizers and hybrid seeds to modifying the genetics of seeds as well as animals to be used for food. We now have "terminator" seeds which will not reproduce after the year they were developed. Farmers will no longer be able to save back their own seeds for replanting. Fortunately, there are those farmers who recognized this evil and saved back their "open pollinated" seed, the same kind our grandfathers used!

It is these agrochemical multinational companies who are now deep into the water business. The chemical giant Monsanto, for example, presents the following as their new code of ethics: "The business logic of sustainable development is that population growth and economic development will apply increasing pressure on natural resource markets. These pressures and the world's desire to prevent the consequences of these pressures if unabated will create vast economic opportunity. When we look at the world through the lens of sustainability, we are in a position to see current and foresee impending resources, market trends and imbalances that create market needs. We have further focused this lens on the resource market of water and landWe are particularly enthusiastic about the potential of partnering with the International Finance Corporation (IFC) of the World Bank to jointventure projects in developing markets. The IFC is eager to work with Monsanto to commercialize sustainability opportunities and would bring both investment capital and on the ground capabilities to our efforts."

At the beginning of this issue we revealed the efforts of our own government bringing legal action to acquire the "ownership" of all waters which originate on Federal lands. To this writer, this action can only mean that the intentions are to make private the water supply of the Western States. With the "track record" our government has shown over the past fifty years doing everything possible to be a total partner in the United Nations, one can only assume that our waters could soon be privately owned.

The next logical question is whether such a move would be to the best interests of the people of the United States? That question then brings forth another question. What will be the response of the American people if it is attempted? To guide us in such a question, we must ask if there are examples of privatization of water in other countries and what have been the results? Indeed, we do have examples.

Maude Barlow, in her book *Blue Gold.- The Global Water Crisis and the Commodification of the World's Water Supply* gives us examples: "The privatization of municipal water services has a terrible record that is well documented. Customer rates are doubled or tripled; corporate profits rise as much as 700 percent; corruption and bribery are rampant; water quality standards drop, sometimes dramatically, overuse is promoted to make money; and customers who can't are cut off. When privatization hits the Third World, those who can't pay will die."

She continues with the example in Bolivia, "In 1998 the World Bank refused to guarantee a US \$25-million loan to refinance water services in Cochabamba, Bolivia's third-largest city, unless the government sold the public water system to the private sector and passed on the costs to consumers. Only one bid was considered, and the utility was turned over to a subsidiary of a conglomerate led by [Bechtel](#)- the giant engineering company implicated in the infamous Three Gorges Dam in China, which has caused the forced relocation of 1.3 million people. In January 1999, before it had even hung up its shingle, the company announced the doubling of water prices. For most Bolivians, this meant that water would now cost more than food; for those on a minimum wage or unemployed, water bills suddenly accounted for close to half their monthly budgets. To add insult, the World Bank granted monopolies to private water concessionaires, announced its support for full-cost water pricing, pegged the cost of water to the US dollar, and declared that none of its loan could be used to subsidize the poor for water services. All water, even from community wells, required permits to access, and peasants and **small farmers even had to buy permits to gather rainwater on their property.**" On the 10th of April 2000, hundreds of thousands marched to Cochabamba in an anti-government protest. The government backed down, ordered Bechtel out of Bolivia, and revoked its water privatization legislation.

One can only wonder what would happen in the United States-if that happened here?
Would it be the same as what happened in Seattle during the demonstrations against the [World Trade Organization](#)?
