WHO DO YOU SAY THAT I AM?



¹³Now when Jesus came into the district of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, "Who do people say that the Son of Man is?" ¹⁴And they said, "Some say John the Baptist, but others Elijah, and still others Jeremiah or one of the prophets." ¹⁵He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" Matthew 16:13-15

During a sermon on August 27, I mentioned that Matthew makes a pivot in his gospel in chapter 16 and begins to focus on the actions and responsibilities of what it means to be a follower of Christ. I began serving God at Mt. Hermon on October 1, 2018. On the

first Sunday in October, I will begin my 6th year of ministry at Mt. Hermon. We have engaged in life changing ministries and it's time for a faith pivot! We are at the point that Matthew writes about beginning in the 16th chapter of his gospel. Matthew asks, "Who do you say that Jesus is?" I ask the same question and additionally, I ask, "And why do you believe, understand, profess that Jesus is the Son of Man. What is your answer when someone asks you: Who is Jesus?"

These next months, my focus will be on giving you tools to help you be able to tell each other, someone off the street, your co-worker, and your family: <u>Who Jesus is to you</u>. One tool will be this copy of Sean McGever's, *New Testament in a Year*. More than 26 of you have asked for and received a copy of this bible. I pledge to buy as many as we need for each of you who want one – will have one. I know some of you like reading from your



electronic devices and this is also available on kindle. Beginning in January, as we all get on the same page again. We will begin reading parts of these daily readings as our Sunday morning readings. He is up to something in His Word, and he wants to share his vision and his word with us, his faithful followers.

I am working on a series of Bible studies for next year as we discover the why and how's of each of the books of the New Testament – for now, we just need to start the habit of reading a couple of minutes each day and then we will dig deeper, much deeper into God's living word for God's people who follow him.

Who is your Jesus? Why would you want to tell anyone about him? Why does Jesus' matter in the world then? Why does he matter today? Let's learn and study together as we dig into His word for us!






