Fabric Requirements and Supply List for Hover-Quilting Inspiration Workshop!

Here are the fabric requirements and suggested supply list for the Hover-quilting Inspiration Workshop. There are 38 pieces in total in each kit.

There you will find video overviews on how to make your kit and pictures of the specific within each zone. This will be a great help with readying yourself for the workshop!

Let's get started with our fabric. If you are putting together your own kit, here's what you will need to cut in advance of the workshop!

Cutting Instructions:

- 1. Quilt backing: cut 1 piece of fabric measuring 18 inches square.
- 2. Binding: cut 2 x 2 ¼ inches (or 2 ½ inches for a wider binding) x WOF (Width of Fabric) in a solid, light green fabric.
- 3. Binding flange: cut 1 piece of coordinating fabric measuring 2 x 17.
- 4. Batting: cut 1 piece of cotton or cotton/poly batting 18 inches square.
- 5. Quilt top # 1: cut 1 piece of black fabric or white fabric measuring 18 inches square.

Zone 1: Blues, 4 ½ inches square.

1 x light blue print with a medium blue solid, 4 ½ inches square.
1 x a quarter cut unit of the same light blue print paired with a quarter cut of red print from zone 2. Cut a 4 ½ inch square diagonally from corner to corner in both directions to make a quarter cut unit. This pairing will make one HST. (1 HST)
1 x medium blue print with a light blue solid, 4 ½ inches square.
1 x a quarter cut unit of the same medium blue print paired with a quarter cut of red print from zone two. Cut the 4 ½ inch square diagonally from corner to corner in both directions to make a quarter cut unit. This pairing will make one HST. (1 HST)
1 x dark blue print with a light teal blue solid, 4 ½ inches square.

1 x light pink print with the same light teal blue solid, 4 ½ inches square.

Zone 2: Oranges, 4 ½ inches square.

- 1 x dark red print paired with a dark orange solid, 4 ½ inches square.
- 1 x red print paired with a light orange solid, 4 ½ inches square.
- 1 x dark pink print paired with a light cheddar cheese solid, 4 ½ inches square.
- 1 x medium pink print with a medium orange solid. To achieve the right size triangular unit, take a 4 ½ inch square and cut once diagonally from corner to corner. This pairing will make two HST's.

Zone 3: Greens, 4 ½ inches square.

1 x dark green solid paired with a dark green print, 4 ½ inches square.

The next three pairings are all cut from a four and a half inch squares cut diagonally from corner to corner. Each pairing of large triangles will make 2 HST's.

- 1 x medium green solid paired with the same dark red print from zone 2. (2HST's)
- 1 x the same medium green solid paired with the same dark pink from zone 2. (2 HST's)
- 1 x light green solid paired with a medium green print. (2 HST's)

Let's gather your supplies!

1. For sewing your quilting stitches, if you would like to colour match your thread, I suggest a spool of 50 weight thread in black or white, light blue, light green and peach/orange.

If you are not colour matching your thread, go with a light neutral colour for all of your quilting stitches.

- 2. For piecing together the half square triangles (HST's) you will need a medium tone, neutral, 50 weight thread.
- 3. A pair of Snips.
- 4. A pair of shears.
- 5. A 28mm rotary cutter with **new blade.** (Optional)_
- 6. A 45mm rotary cutter with new blade. (A must have)_
- 7. A cutting mat.
- 8. Wash away, non-permanent glue sticks from the dollar store. One 3-pack is ample._
- 9. One seam roller.(Optional)_
- 10. A face cloth sized rag for wiping glue off of your fingers._
- 11. A small quilting ruler measuring about 6 inch x 6 inch.
- 12. A larger quilting ruler measuring about 3 inch x 18 inch, or 6 inch by 24 inch._
- 13. A Walking Foot.(A must have)_
- 14. The ¼ inch presser foot. (A must have)._
- 15. The standard presser feet. (A must have)_
- 16. A white marking pencil._
- 17. A dark marking pencil.
- 18. A pressing board._
- 19. An iron._
- 20. A positive outlook and a willingness to gather all these supply's! _
