CONFIRMATION PROCEDURE

We will send the parent/legal guardian a notification confirming whether or not registration can be made as requested. A confirmation package will be sent after a program has been filled to capacity or approximately one month prior to commencement of the hockey school, whichever occurs first. If a desired program is already filled to capacity, we will provide an alternative or the option of being placed on a waiting list.

The confirmation package may contain additional information and notice of changes.

EQUIPMENT POLICY

Before any child is allowed on the ice, the child must be dressed in full and properly fitting hockey equipment. Parents/legal guardians are responsible for participants being fully dressed and ready for ice times.

CANCELLATION OR REFUND POLICY

All cancellation requests must be submitted in writing. A full refund will be issued providing the cancellation request is received before August 1, 2019. After that date, only emergency cancellation due to illness and/or injury will be considered. The cancellation must have supporting medical certificate(s) and will be handled on a case-by-case basis. 
