Not Accepted

- Glass
- Plastic bags
- Green waste
- Aerosol cans
- Plastic cutlery
- Waxed cartons
- Packing peanuts
- Pyrex & ceramics
- Hazardous waste
- Dirty food containers
- Oil or antifreeze containers
- Milk, juice cartons w/waxed coating
- Electronic waste (computers, cell phones)

Contamination!

These items **MUST** be kept out of Single-Stream Recycling bins. Contaminated loads will be discarded.

How to Recycle

RINSE containers, throw lids into regular trash.

TOSS ITEMS directly into blue bins. Do not bag recyclable items.

ALWAYS dispose of hazardous waste properly. Do not put hazardous waste into trash or recycling bins. Contact the landfill with questions.

DO NOT overload bin.
