

Level 2: Intermediate Knitting: Christmas Stocking Class

This class is designed for the intermediate student. Must know how to cast on/off, knit, and purl.

Objectives: Advancing your skills. We will review and/or learn the following:

- Knitting in the round with two circulars
- Creating short rows
- Creating a gusset by increasing
- Working with multiple colors
- Adjusting a pattern

Class Meeting: This class will meet for two hours over three days, from 2:30 PM until 4:30 PM on Wednesday, August 10, AND Wednesday, August 24, AND Wednesday, September 21.

Materials: You will need multiple colors of heavy worsted weight yarn (probably works best with three, but feel free to choose more!), two 24" long circular needles in U.S. size 6 or 7, stitch markers, waste yarn, and a blunt needle to weave in ends. The student will pick out their own designs chosen from the samples Lynne will provide. Lynne has also ordered some appropriate yarn in multiple colors, and she can help the student pick out colors. Plus, there's a 10% discount on the yarn and notions you buy for this class.
