

**ORDINANCE NO. 29**

**Amendment to Ordinance No. 20 Licensing and Regulating the Sale of Non-intoxicating Malt Liquors.**

The Village Council of New Munich do ordain that Ordinance No. 20 be amended by the addition thereto of the following four sections:

Section 1. No license shall be issued to any person who has a twenty-five dollar federal occupational tax receipt unless such person has a license to sell intoxicating liquor in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 46, Extra Session Laws of 1933-34, and acts amendatory thereof.

Section 2. Right to Search and Seize.—Any peace officer shall have the unqualified right to enter, inspect and search the premises of a licensee hereunder, during business hours, without a search and seizure warrant, and seize all intoxicating liquors found on the premises of such licensee, unless such licensee has an intoxicating liquor license issued under the provisions of Chapter 46, Extra Session Laws of 1933-34, and acts amendatory thereof.

Section 3. License Automatically Revoked.—The presence of intoxicating liquors on the premises of a licensee hereunder, unless said licensee has an intoxicating liquor license issued under the provisions of Chapter 46, Extra Session Laws of 1933-34, and acts amendatory thereof, shall be prima facie evidence of possession of intoxicating liquors for the purpose of sale, and the license granted to said licensee shall be automatically forfeited without the necessity of formal action by the council (board).

Section 4. Intoxicating Liquor Forbidden.—No licensee not having an intoxicating liquor license issued under the provisions of Chapter 46, Extra Session Laws of 1933-34, and acts amendatory thereof shall permit the consumption of intoxicating liquors on the licensed premises, nor shall any licensee serve soft drinks to be used for "mixing" purposes.
