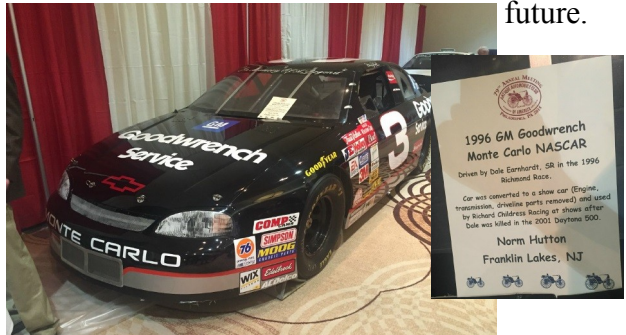
A highbrow event for sure. I was waiting to see if Earl and Judy were going to start dancing. You know how those crazy kids can dance!

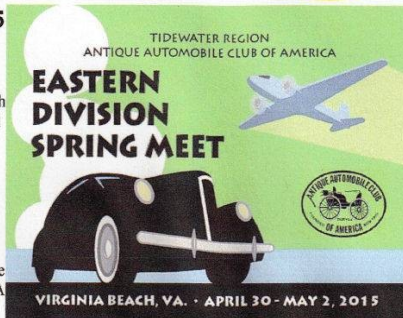

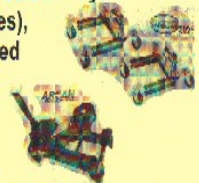


Cruise-in Fundraiser for Surrey Girls Charity

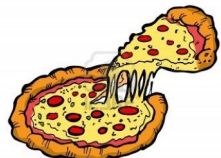
