

Letter from the Editor



Each year the TTC gives out Scholarships to High School Seniors or College students. 2020 has come with many challenges but we still gave out our annual scholarships at the TTC Golf Outing this August. This year we gave out 3 awards and only 5 students applied for a scholarship. So in this letter from the editor I would like to cover what the requirements are to apply for a scholarship and also ask for your help in funding our scholarship fund.

Just like with any other organization TTC funding was lower this year than in previous years. As we are all aware of COVID-19 has certainly taken a toll on all of us. If you would like to help our scholarship fund please include an extra donation along with your Annual Due or contact Rich Pursel anytime throughout the year to make a donation to the Scholarship Fund. We will also sell small ads or 1/4, 1/2 and full page ads in our Newsletters as a way to help fund our Scholarships as well. For as little as \$25 you can put a small ad in our newsletter or the more you donate the larger the ad can be all the way up to full page. See below for the breakdown.

Who can apply for a Scholarship? That's a great question and I'm sure is on the mind of many. Any High School Senior or currently enrolled College Student that is sponsored by an active TTC Member. So what exactly is an "Active TTC Member"? If you're a TTC Member and your dues for the current year are paid you are an "Active TTC Member" You write a short letter of recommendation for the student applying and they are in the running. Family members of active members get an extra bonus point but any student can apply and win. Every one of us knows someone that is a High School Senior or College student. So watch for the new Scholarship application to be posted on the TTC Website and Newsletter in January each year.

How are the winners selected? Another Great question. Each application is given points based on family of a TTC Member or not family. Points are awarded for having a job, being involved in extracurricular activities and doing some kind of service with a non profit organization. Points are also awarded based on the students GPA. Each student is also asked to write a 500 word essay. This essay is graded by 3 teachers and based off the grades each teacher gives the student gets points are awarded. All these points are tabulated and the top 3 students with the most points are awarded scholarships.
