1. Laying of the Levy – FY 2018-19

Mayor Dettmer explained this is a formality which we have to vote on and approve. The rates are set by the County. Mayor Dettmer went over each Class of Property Tax and told the projected amount of tax we are to receive. Mayor Dettmer also explained we do not have home rule.
