

Deterling & Darling Award Criteria

The **Deterling & Darling Awards** are presented annually in recognition of an outstanding original paper presented by a fellow, resident or medical student at the Society's Annual Meeting. Work considered for the Deterling & Darling Awards can be clinical research or basic science.

The clinical or laboratory research must be original and not have been previously published. A majority of the work must have been performed by the trainee, although more senior colleagues may serve as advisors, collaborators and/or co-authors and assume responsibility for the research.

Selection will be made by the Awards Committee onsite at the Annual Meeting following presentation of all contending submissions. Both the presentation and the completed manuscript will be used by the Committee to choose each award winner.

Recipients currently receive an award of \$1,000 and a certificate of recognition.

Fellows, residents and medical students wishing to have their submission considered for an award should indicate this when submitting their abstract online.
