

For all weddings and events that occur at Borderland State Park, a Special Use Permit must be obtained. To obtain a Special Use Permit, please visit the Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation's (DCR) Permit website: <https://www.mass.gov/how-to/apply-for-a-state-parks-special-use-permit>

For first time users, the online permit process can be difficult to navigate, here are a few items you should know / have for this process. Please note: at any time during the process, you can save your work and continue at a later date.

Things to know:

- Create an account
- Event information, including route maps, site setup, and dates

- If you work for a nonprofit, please include a copy of your 501C3 determination letter
- Certificate of liability insurance (upon approval)
