### GENERAL RULES

1. LOSS, INJURY OR DAMAGE to horse, rider, owner, coach, groom, spectator or other individuals is in no way the responsibility of the Madison County Fair Management or the Show Committee.
2. English and Western classes follow USEF rules. **\*\*Exception** for Western Pleasure: Chaps are optional but **NO** blue jeans.  
Gymkhana follows 4H rules. **\*\*Additions:** A chin strap (chain or leather) be used on snaffle bits for safety. Helmets are encouraged but not required for riders over the age of 18. Western hat **IS** required if not wearing a helmet.
3. INSUFFICIENT ENTRIES in a class shall result in the cancellation of that class. The Show Committee also reserves the right to divide, combine or add any classes it deems necessary for the good of the show. In classes offering prize money, the Show Committee reserves the right to run any class as a Sweepstakes if there are less than six (6) entries.
4. ONLY JUDGES and those having duties to perform shall be allowed in the ring during times of judged competition.
5. A CERTIFICATE OF A NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST, performed in the current or previous calendar year, must be presented before exhibitor numbers will be issued.  
ALL EQUINES ENTERING ANY NYS COUNTY FAIR OR THE NYS STATE FAIR MUST BE ACTIVELY IMMUNIZED AGAINST RABIES. VACCINE MUST BE ADMINISTERED AT LEAST FOURTEEN (14) DAYS PRIOR TO ARRIVAL ON FAIRGROUNDS. VACCINATION CERTIFICATE FROM YOUR VETERINARIAN MUST ACCOMPANY EACH EQUINE. EQUINES NOT MEETING THESE REQUIREMENTS WILL BE REJECTED FROM THE PREMISES.
6. SCHOOLING. "Controlled" free schooling will be permitted between 7:00 AM to 8:00 AM each morning and in the evening.
7. NUMBERS must be worn by Exhibitors in the ring at all times. No charge for numbers.
8. A SIGNED CHECK PAYABLE TO "Madison County Fair" must accompany pre-entries or left with the show secretary prior to receiving numbers.
9. **Post entries will be accepted the day of the show at an extra charge of \$2.00 per class. Post entries and scratches must be made one hour prior to the start of the class.**
10. Stall reservations are on a first come, first served basis and will not be held without full payment.
11. STALL DEPOSIT of \$25 must be paid in full with separate check made out to: Madison County Fair. Stall deposit will be returned at the end of the competition provided the stall has been cleaned and stripped.
12. MAIL ENTRIES AND STALL FEES with checks payable to "Madison County Fair" to Horse Show Superintendent, Karen Nowak, BRDA, PO Box 250, Brookfield, NY 13314
13. HORSES MAY NOT ENTER GROUNDS BEFORE 2:00 PM Thursday, July 12th.
14. There will be **NO cross-entering divisions with the exception of** the Standardbred division.
15. **Riders 18 years & under must wear ASTM/SEI approved PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR at all times when mounted per New York State law and for ALL jumping.**

**Open Hunter** - Open to exhibitors any age, amateurs & professionals. Riders to show walk, trot and canter. Fences not to exceed 2'6". Martingales permitted in classes 1 & 7 ONLY. Six ribbons in this class.

**Youth Hunter** - Open to riders age 17 and under. Riders to show walk, trot and canter. Fences not to exceed 2'3" in hunter division. Martingales permitted in classes 3 & 8 ONLY. Six ribbons in each class. \*\*Will split if more than 6 entries in each group (riders 18 and over, riders 17 and under).

**Novice Hunter** - Open to exhibitors of any age and/or horses/ponies in their 1st or 2nd year showing at the canter and who have never competed over fences higher than 2'. The combination may show in any flat class for which they are eligible, but may not compete over fences higher than 2'.

The Novice Equitation classes are open to Novice riders ONLY.  
Martingales permitted in class 5 ONLY. Six ribbons in each class.

**Beginner Walk/Trot Hunter (Adud Youth)** - Open to riders of all ages who have not won 3 blue ribbons in this division at any show. Riders in this division cannot show in any other division(s). Crossrails and/or ground rails will be offered. Martingales prohibited. Six ribbons in each class.

**Green Horse** - Open to horses in their first 2 years of showing. This is a **WALK/TROT** division. Judging is based on the HORSE. Horses in this division may not enter any canter classes at this show. Riders in this division may enter any other classes they are qualified for on a different horse. Martingales permitted in class 11 ONLY. May be shown in a snaffle bit in class 46. Six ribbons in each class.

**Standardbred Division** - Open to registered Standardbreds to promote the versatility of the breed. Horses are to show at a walk, trot **or** pace. **\*\*Gait break (swap from the pace to the trot and vice versa) will be penalized.**

Martingales NOT permitted. Six ribbons in each class.

**Open Western Pleasure** - Open to exhibitors any age, amateurs & professionals. Riders to show walk, jog and lope. Tie-downs/martingales NOT permitted. Six ribbons in each class

**Youth Western Pleasure** - Open to riders age 17 and under. Riders to show walk, jog and lope. Tie-downs/martingales NOT permitted. Six ribbons in each class. **\*\*Will split if more than 6 entries in each group (riders 18 and over, riders 17 and under).**

**Novice Western Pleasure (Adult and Youth)** - Open to exhibitors of any age **and/or** horses/ponies in their 1st or 2nd year showing at the lope. Riders to show walk, jog and lope. Tie-downs/martingales NOT permitted. The combination may show in any flat class for which they are eligible. The Novice Equitation class is open to Novice riders ONLY. Six ribbons in each class.
