

# Clinical Sex Therapy



## **Program Overview**

The Colorado School For Family Therapy has the only accredited Certificate in Sex Therapy program in the region. The American Board of Sexology, headquartered in Florida, accredits the program. Certification requires one year of postgraduate, five class program. Classes begin in August/September.

## **The six required classes include:**

1. Sex Therapy I: Human Sexuality and Couples
2. Sex Therapy II: Disorders and Dysfunctions
3. Sex Therapy III: Medical and Physiological Issues
4. Sex Therapy IV: Abuse, Trauma, and Deviance
5. Sex Therapy V: Treatment of IDD, Juvenile and Adult Sex Offenders
6. Sex Therapy VI: Treating Survivors of Human Trafficking

The Colorado School for Family Therapy is approved and regulated by the Colorado Department of Higher Education, Private Occupation School Board.

The School is also approved for Veterans benefits by the Colorado State Approving Agency.

## **Eligibility**

Clinicians with a Masters degree in a mental health-related field, licensure candidates, licensees, and graduate students in counseling related disciplines are eligible to enter the Certificate in Sex Therapy program.

## **Program cost and content**

The total cost of the Certificate in Sex Therapy program is \$3,600.00 (six classes x 600.00). Each of the six classes may be taken as “stand alone courses” at the cost of \$600.00 per class.

*Graduates of the School may be eligible for Sex Therapy licensure in Florida, the only state that currently has such licensure.*
