Letter from our Pastor

Dear Friends in Christ,

“Who is able to comprehend the mystery of the Trinity for height and depth are filled by Him and is not subject to inquiry? The Father begot the Only-Begotten, the First-Born Son became man, and the Holy Spirit is the Paraclete, the Perfecter and Completer. Glory be to the Hidden One who is uncontainable in His nature – Three Adorable Persons, One Lordship glorified by creation.”

-From the Syriac Maronite Rite of Kneeling for the Feast of Pentecost

The Feast of the Holy Trinity comes to us from the Latin Church and its liturgical cycle. The opening hymn for today’s liturgy is taken from the first watch of the traditional Rite of Kneeling from the Feast of Pentecost. The hymnodist asks, “Who is able to comprehend the mystery of the Trinity?” and notes that “height and depth” are filled by God’s Presence – meaning that all of Creation is filled with God but is not able to contain Him. The hymnodist also states that the Mystery of the Trinity is “not subject to inquiry.” We, as finite creatures, are unable to plunge into the depths of the immense mystery of the Godhead and even if we were to try we would never be able to fully understand. He goes on to write, “Glory be to the Hidden One who is uncontainable in His nature...” showing us that God cannot be contained – by Heaven, by Earth, or by our intellect. We can only glorify the Mystery of the Trinity and praise the Hidden One through the names that He has revealed to us – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Staying Connected. During these difficult, and ever-changing times, it is important that we be able to communicate **quickly** and **efficiently**. Returning to Liturgy. As our region transitions into the "Green Phase" of the reopening process for Pennsylvania we begin to return to a more normal routine in our lives. Those who are in a **high risk** demographic are **encouraged to continue participating in liturgies from home**. For the rest of us, as we **return to regular church attendance**, we have added an **extra anticipated liturgy on Saturdays at 4:00pm** to facilitate social distancing.

Syriac Classes. We will begin our parish Syriac Class on **Tuesday, 9 June at 7:00pm**. You may join us in person in the Parish Hall or virtually on **Zoom**. Please note that **regular attendance is important** for full benefit of the class and, as in all things, completing the **homework** will be part of the experience!

Graduates. We would like to congratulate **Abby Rozgony** for graduating from **California University of Pennsylvania** with a **Masters of Science in Criminal Justice!** If there are any other graduates from the parish please let us know so we can recognize you.

Apostles' Fast. The Ancient Apostles' Fast before the **Feast of Sts. Peter and Paul** begins on **Wednesday, 10 June until 28 June**. The obligatory days of the Apostles' Fast as decreed by the Synod of Mount Lebanon (1736) are **25-28 June**. The usual fasting practices are observed.

Live Streams. Liturgies will be streamed on **Tuesday and Thursday at 6:00pm, Sunday at 10:30am, and on Feasts at 6:00pm**.

Liturgy Intentions. If you would like to schedule a liturgy for a loved one or any other intention, please **contact the parish office**, send a note via **mail** or **collection basket**, or **email**. Suggested stipend is \$20. If you have already scheduled a recurring monthly or yearly liturgy please **remember** to send in your stipend before the liturgy is celebrated.
