<p>Our units this term are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Revise doubles and corresponding halves to 30 - Revise and recognise 1/2s, 1/4s, 1/3s and 2/3s of shapes; place 1/2s on a number line; count in 1/2s and 1/4s; understand and write mixed numbers. - Count in 2s, 5s and 10s to solve multiplication problems and find specified multiples - introduce the x sign; record the 2, 5 and 10 times-tables - write multiplications to go with arrays - Tell the time to the nearest quarter of an hour using analogue and digital clocks - understand the relationship between seconds, minutes and hours and use a tally chart 	<p>This term our focus will be on healthy and safer lifestyle.</p> <p>Pupils will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Have a basic understanding of how things can get in the body and that some can be helpful and some can be harmful - Be looking into safety rules concerning medicines - Looking at alternatives to medicine that might help us feel better such as exercise. 	<p>It is really important that your child comes to school every day and is ready to learn.</p> <p>Weekly homework to be completed and given to their class teacher on time.</p> <p>Children must read at home at least 4 times a week.</p>
