

2021-2022 Course Catalog:

Manicuring and Sculpted Nails Program

Program Objective

This program is designed to prepare the student for the State Board Examination upon successful completion of 600 clock hours. Students will learn the art of manicuring, hand and arm massage, the treatment of nails, and artificial nails. Upon receiving a professional license, the student will possess the skills and knowledge to be employed in entry-level manicuring and sculptured nail positions.

Admission Requirements

-Proof of completion of the 10th grade, High School Diploma or GED
-Minimum age of 16 (must be 17 years of age before completion of the program)

Student Schedule

This course takes approximately 19 weeks to complete with the hours of 8:45 AM to 5 PM Monday - Friday.
