On February 26 at 09:21 am, Officer Joseph Fullam was conducting traffic enforcement on State Highway Route 208. Officer Fullam observed a vehicle pass his location travelling at a high rate of speed. Officer Fullam stopped the vehicle and the subsequent investigation led to the arrest of Shaun P Kalinsky, Ringwood, age 36 and Briana S Penzarella, New York, age 30. Kalinsky was charged with possession of marijuana, possession of paraphernalia, speeding, careless driving and possession of C.D.S. in a motor vehicle. Penzarella was charged with possession of marijuana and possession of paraphernalia. Both were processed and released with a scheduled court date. Sergeant Mark Tagliareni, Officer Kyle Ferreira and Officer Michael Flim assisted.

On March 7 at 01:12 am, Officer Joseph Fullam was conducting traffic enforcement on State Highway Route 208. Officer Fullam observed a vehicle pass his location travelling at a high rate of speed. She was charged with possession of marijuana, violating a driver's learning permit, obstructed view, failure to possess a driver's license and possession of C.D.S. in a motor vehicle.
