

This matter came before the Court for a final hearing on the Plaintiffs' and Petitioners complaint in lieu of prerogative writs, in which the Plaintiffs seek court review and approval of the petition to deannex South Seaside Park from the Township of Berkeley; Joseph Micheleni, Esq., appearing on behalf of the Plaintiffs/Petitioners; Gregory McGuckin Esq., appearing on behalf of the defendant Township Council of Berkeley Township; and the Court having considered the submissions of the parties, the exhibits marked into evidence, the oral argument of counsel; and the court having issued a written letter opinion dated July 12, 2022 setting forth the findings and conclusions of the court, and for good cause shown,

It is on this 12th day of July, 2022, Ordered and Adjudged:

1. That for the reasons set forth in the written opinion of the court dated July 12, 2022, which is incorporated into this Order for Final Judgment by reference, Judgment shall be entered in favor of the Plaintiffs.

2. That this final Judgment shall be considered as authorization for the petitioners seeking deannexation from Berkeley Township to make application to the governing body of the Borough of Seaside Park to seek annexation;
3. That the provisions of this order shall be effective 45 days from the entry of this order;
