February 7, 2016 Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Luke 5:1-11

Simon was not only a fisherman, he was engaged in the business of fishing. He and his brother Andrew were partners with James and John, sons of Zebedee. Fish were an important source of protein for the people of the time of Jesus. The business of catching and selling fish involved hard worked, but was profitable. A man in the business of fishing would probably not take advice from a carpenter about where to fish, especially after a whole night without a catch. But Simon, the fisherman, did not do what the man from Nazareth told him to do because he was a carpenter; he did it because he had heard what Jesus said and saw what he had done. After hauling a large catch of fish, Simon, the fisherman, would continue to follow Jesus; to learn from him; to grow in his faith in Jesus as the Messiah. He would eventually be transformed into Peter, the Fisher of Men. He lived his life and accepted his death because of his faith in Jesus. He is a model for everyone who claims to believe in Jesus.
