A Note From Rick: A very active market on Tuesday at TLA. Spring weather has shown its presence outside but also in the sale ring. We've had a lot more cattle to offer in all categories and prices have remained steady to stronger across the board. We had a nice offering of feeders on Tuesday with the majority of them being dairy replacement heifers. Prices for dairy replacements, as well as, Holstein steers were both from \$80 to \$90/lb. Calf prices remain very strong in my opinion and doesn't seem to have been effected by the increase in feed costs, which is a bit of a surprise to me. Slaughter cattle and slaughter cows have also remained steady over the last several weeks with breaker cows in the low 60's, boner cows in the mid to high 50's and lean cows in the 40's and low 50's. Holstein steers are in the low to mid 90's for the better kind and mixed steers from \$1.05 to \$1.10. Dairy cattle prices for springing heifers and fresh cows is unchanged for the most part as well. The better end of the cattle, both springing and fresh are from \$1250 to \$1500 with the second cut selling for \$900 to \$1200. Enjoy the Spring weather and be safe! Hope to see you at TLA!
